


# UPDATE: Track Work at Hurontario Street and Sandstone Drive/Brunel Road

March 3 to March 16, 2026.

Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



## What You Need to Know

Necessary track rework at the intersection of Sandstone Drive/Brunel Road and Hurontario Street will begin on March 3, 2026 until March 16, 2026. This track rework is being done to ensure safe operations of the future light rail vehicles.

This work requires left-turn restrictions from northbound Hurontario Street to Sandstone Drive. Crews will be performing rework including track installation and concrete pouring. Detour routes will be available through via Britannia Road West and Avebury Road.

Construction work at this intersection will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Saturday, until completion. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Sandstone Drive/Brunel Road be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk with the exception of the south crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

## TIMING

- There will be left-turn restrictions from northbound Hurontario Street to Sandstone Drive from March 3 to March 16, 2026.
- These restrictions will be in place for 24 hours daily, Monday to Sunday.
- The work is scheduled to happen from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Saturday, until completion.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please follow the posted detour signs.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
- Access for emergency services will be always maintained during these works.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk near the work area will be impacted.
- Please follow pedestrian detour signage as sidewalks may be closed.
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk with the exception of the south crosswalk.

## PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require private property access for this work.
