

UPDATE: Track Work at Hurontario Street and Barondale Drive

March 16 at 10 p.m. to April 13, 2026 at 10 p.m.
Monday to Sunday, 24 hours a day



What You Need to Know

Necessary track rework at the intersection of Barondale Drive and Hurontario Street will begin on March 16, 2026 until April 13, 2026. This track rework is being done to ensure safe operations of the future light rail vehicles.

This work requires left-turn restrictions at the intersection of Barondale Drive and Hurontario Street. Crews will be performing rework including track installation and concrete pouring. Detour routes will be available through via Bristol Road and Wildwood Trail.

Construction work at this intersection may be scheduled to take place 24 hours per day, until completion. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street at Barondale Drive will not be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized

crosswalk with the exception of the north crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

Transit services will be impacted by these track works. Please visit www.miway.ca/updates and www.brampton.ca/transit for updates on your bus route.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- There will be left-turn restrictions at the intersection of Hurontario Street and Barondale Drive from March 16 to April 13, 2026.
- These restrictions will be in place for 24 hours daily, Monday to Sunday.
- The work may be scheduled to take place 24 hours per day, until completion.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please follow the posted detour signs.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
- Access for emergency services will be maintained during these works.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- Please visit MiWay.ca, BramptonTransit.com and gotransit.com for updates on your bus route.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk near the work area will be impacted.
- Please follow pedestrian detour signage as sidewalks may be closed.
- Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk with the exception of the north crosswalk.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require private property access for this work.
