


Site servicing: Berkeley Street

Expected start date: March 10, 2026

Expected end date: Up to five days

What is happening?

- As part of the Ontario Line construction at Corktown Station, crews will install temporary water and sanitary site services.
- Partial closure of the sidewalk is required to ensure public safety during installation.
- Work will begin as early as March 10, 2026, and is expected to take up to five (5) days to complete.

What to expect

- Work is expected to take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. from Monday to Friday. Additional working hours may be required to complete work.
- Partial closure of the east Berkeley Street sidewalk between King Street East and Front Street East.
- Pedestrian access will be temporarily detoured to the west sidewalk on Berkeley Street.
- Crews are expected to be on-site prior to 7 a.m. for equipment set-up.
- Minor noise from the use of a mini-excavator, skid steer, and various other drills and saws is expected during installation hours.
- Flag-persons will be present to assist pedestrians near impacted sidewalks.
- Safety barriers will be used to separate pedestrians and motorists from the work zones.
- Two-way roadway traffic will be maintained at all times.
- Clear signage will be posted for transit riders, pedestrians, and motorists.
- Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Equipment will be cleared after working hours, and the sidewalk will be accessible between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
