


Long Branch GO: Weekend and Overnight Work

March 20, 11:00 p.m. to March 23, 6:00 a.m.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

As a part of GO Expansion, there will be planned construction taking place on the Lakeshore West rail corridor, beginning on March 20 to March 23. During this time Long Branch GO Station will be closed. Construction crews will be installing utilities under railway tracks 1 and 2 (northern platform). Pieces of rail will be cut and removed, a trench will then be excavated, and the utilities will be installed. The trench will then be refilled and the tracks reinstated and inspected. This work will take place over the weekend, in the daytime and at night. *We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your patience as we take this important step toward building the new station.*

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15-minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service. This includes accessibility and amenity improvements to Toronto's Long Branch GO Station

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Residents should expect noise, vibration, and site lighting from construction activities.
- Machinery and tools such as Excavators, dump trucks, hi-rail service truck, welding truck, compaction tamper, ballast tamper, ballast regulator, and a stabilizer will be present on site.
- Crews will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - White noise back up beacons on machinery.

HOURS OF WORK

- Day and night (daytime work within closed parking lot area and nighttime work within the rail corridor)
 - Daytime work hours: 6:00 AM – 6:00 PM
 - Nighttime work hours: 6:00 PM – 6:00 AM

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will be taking place on tracks 1 and 2 (northern platform) but will be supported from both the northern and southern access points of the work zone.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Increased construction vehicles and equipment will be expected in the vicinity of both the north and south access points of the work zone.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Pedestrians will not be able to access Long Branch GO during the weekend
- The temporary pathway from Edgeware Drive will remain open, however access to the north platform from the temporary pathway will be closed.
- Please continue to exercise caution around active construction sites.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- There will be no GO Transit service at Appleby, Bronte, Port Credit, Long Branch, Mimico, or Exhibition GO. Please consider TTC or local transit options to help you complete your trip.
