


Lane Restrictions at Hurontario Street and Ray Lawson Boulevard/County Court Boulevard Intersection for Stormwater Work

March 18, 2026 to April 13, 2026



What You Need to Know

Crews will be upgrading the stormwater infrastructure at the intersection of Hurontario Street and Ray Lawson Boulevard from March 18, 2026 to April 13, 2026.

The work will be happening in **five phases**.

- First phase: right turns will be prohibited from Hurontario Street onto County Court Boulevard, left turns will be restricted from Ray Lawson Boulevard onto Hurontario Street and left turns will be restricted from Hurontario Street onto County Court Boulevard.
- Second phase: left and right turns will be prohibited from County Court Boulevard to Hurontario Street.

- Third phase: left turns will be prohibited from County Court Boulevard to Hurontario Street.
- Fourth phase: left turns will be prohibited from Ray Lawson Boulevard to Hurontario Street.
- Fifth phase: left turns will be prohibited from County Court Boulevard to Hurontario street and right turns will be prohibited from Hurontario Street to Ray Lawson Boulevard.

Detour routes will be in place via Sir Lou Drive, Malta Avenue and County Court Boulevard. Traffic control signage and flaggers will be present to safely guide motorists and pedestrians around the work area.

In accordance with City of Brampton Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes and other construction equipment related to this work.

This work is necessary to improve the stormwater infrastructure in the area. We thank you for your patience and understanding.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Please see roadway signage for the latest information. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- There will be traffic restrictions at the intersection of Hurontario Street and Ray Lawson Boulevard/County Court Boulevard from March 18 to April 13, 2026.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please follow the posted detour signs.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
- Access for emergency services will be always maintained during these works.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes,

and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- Brampton Transit bus stops will not be impacted by this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk near the work area will be impacted.
- Please follow pedestrian detour signage as sidewalks may be closed.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require private property access for this work.
