


Overnight track work in the Lakeshore east railway corridor near Aldergrove and Woodbine Aves

23-30 March 2026 & 11-12 April, 2026

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

As part of the GO Expansion project, we will be constructing approximately two kilometres of storage track within the Lakeshore East rail corridor approximately between Jones Avenue and Woodbine Avenue for storing and stabling work trains. This new storage track will support GO Expansion construction by allowing work trains to move construction materials safely overnight while GO trains are not in service.

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

- During the week of March 23-28, we will be removing track panels from the Lakeshore East corridor in the vicinity of Aldergrove Ave and Wildwood Cres. Shown as work zone 1 overleaf.
- On the weekend of March 28-30, we will be removing existing track and ballast and placing new ballast in the area marked at work zone 2 overleaf.
- On the weekend of April 11-12, we will be installing new switch panels and stabilizing them in work zone 1. This work can be disruptive as we make sure the ballast is compacted.
- For safety reasons, we need to carry out these works overnight when there are no trains running on the Lakeshore East railway corridor. We apologize for any inconvenience and will try to reduce disruption as much as we can.

HOURS OF WORK

- During the week of March 23-28, we will be working overnight from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- On the weekend of March 28-30, we will be working from Friday at 11:30 p.m., until Monday at 3:00 a.m.
- On the weekend of April 11-12, we will be working from Saturday at 12:00 a.m., until Monday at 3:00 a.m.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will use an existing trailer site at 108 Wildwood Crescent and rail corridor access point near Aldergrove Avenue to complete this work.

- Residents can expect some noise, vibration, dust near the work areas.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and communities, including:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - White noise backup alarms on vehicles and machinery as required.
 - Noise and vibration monitoring as required.
- Work will take place within of the rail corridor.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- We apologize for any inconvenience as we complete this critical work.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS

- There may be temporary periods of increased truck traffic on designated access routes and local roads near the access gate at Aldergrove Ave.
- Traffic management personnel will be stationed at the access gate during the construction activities.
- Please exercise caution in and around work areas.
