


Supporting Track and Infrastructure Upgrades near the Lakeshore East Corridor and Birchmount Road

March 2026 to August 2026

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid rail system.

What is happening?

As part of the GO Expansion program, crews will begin preparatory work to support track and infrastructure upgrades to accommodate a fourth track within the Lakeshore East rail corridor and to improve operational flexibility. For safety reasons, some work will take place overnight when revenue trains are not in service.

Activities may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Staging area and trailer site setup - Setup of a continuous work and safety zone (overnight) - Fencing and temporary noise barrier installations - Site clearing and tree/vegetation removals - Soil, sediment and environmental controls - Relocating underground utilities - Investigations such as borehole drilling, inspections, subsurface utility engineering or automatic ballast sampling, as required

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will take place Monday to Friday, during daytime and overnight hours, beginning in March 2026, for approximately 4 months.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Residents can expect some noise, vibration, dust and a visual presence of construction crews at staging areas and trailer sites near the rail corridor.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and communities, including but not limited to:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - Pointing lights away from residential windows.
 - White noise backup alarms on vehicles and machinery as required.
 - Noise and vibration monitoring and measures will be applied.
- Work will take place within and outside of the rail corridor on both municipal and Metrolinx lands.

- The scope of work is subject to change and may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS

- There are no anticipated impacts to pedestrians, traffic, or transit at this time. Should conditions change, notifications will be issued in advance.
- Please exercise caution in and around work areas.
