

Overnight work at Martin Grove Road and Eglinton Avenue West

Scheduled start: Monday, March 23, 2026

Expected completion: Mid-April 2026

Construction hours: Weekdays - 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

What is happening?

- Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be conducting overnight work as part of station box construction at the northeast corner of Martin Grove Road and Eglinton Avenue West.
- A station box is an underground box-like structure that forms the main body of a transit station.
- Overnight work includes loading soil into hauling trucks within the construction site. The loaded trucks will then be transferred to an Eglinton Crosstown West Extension site further west.

What to expect

- Residents can expect to see and hear noise from excavators, dump/hauling trucks and equipment. Construction lighting may be visible on the work site.
- Measures are being put in place to reduce dust, including the use of water sprayers and biodegradable dust suppressants.
- Weekend work may be required. Residents will be provided with updates as they are made available.
- The information provided is anticipated based on the current construction schedule and is subject to change.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of Line 5 Eglinton will run 9.2 kilometres from the Mount Dennis Station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
