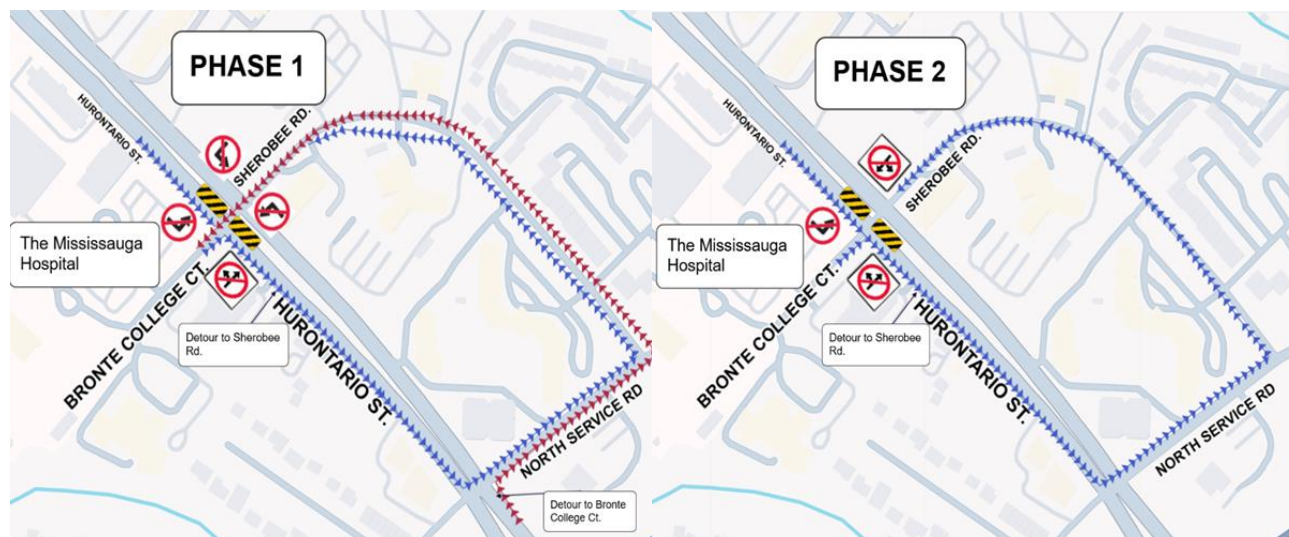


# Track Installations at Bronte College Court/Sherobee Road and Hurontario Street Intersection

Beginning March 31, 2026, 10 pm to May 26, 2026, 10 pm



## What You Need to Know

Crews will be welding tracks and doing concrete work for guideway installations within the intersection of Hurontario Street and Bronte College Court and Sherobee Road. Work at this intersection will take place in two phases to help reduce impacts to the community and Trillium Health Partners. Additional lane closures will be in place during this time for utility work.

Work is scheduled to begin on March 31, 2026, at 10 pm and continue until May 26, 2026, at 10 pm.

### Phase 1:

Crews will begin work on the south side of the intersection. During this time:

- Left turns at the intersection will be restricted.
- Westbound traffic on Sherobee Road and Bronte College Court will remain open.
- Detours will be in place via North Service Road and Sherobee Road.

### Phase 2:

Once the south side is complete, work will move to the north side of the intersection. During this time:

- Northbound left turns from Hurontario Street to Bronte College Court will be allowed (except for trucks)
- Other left turns at the intersection will also be restricted
- Through traffic on Bronte College Court and Sherobee Road will be restricted

Construction may take place at any time, including overnight, to complete the work as quickly as possible. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to help keep traffic moving, and pedestrian access will be maintained at signalized crossings. Please follow posted signs to help guide you safely around the work zone.

As required by the City of Mississauga's Noise By-law Exemption, nearby residents may notice increased noise and vibration from construction equipment such as trucks, excavators, loaders, and backhoes. We appreciate your patience during this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Please see roadway signage for the latest information. ### **TIMING**

- Intersection work is scheduled to begin March 31, 2026 at 10 pm and continue until May 26, 2026 at 10pm.
- Construction can be scheduled to take place 24/7, Monday through Sunday.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### **TRAFFIC DETAILS**

- During Phase 1, northbound left turns at Bronte College Court and Hurontario Street will be restricted.
- During Phase 2, northbound left turns will be permitted from Hurontario Street to Bronte College Court except for trucks.
- Additional lane closures will be in place on Hurontario Street to accommodate construction and utility works.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

### **WHAT TO EXPECT?**

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

- One east-west crosswalk will be maintained at the intersection at all times.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
