

St. Clair-Old Weston Station: Weekend Track Installation Works

Friday, April 17, 2026 (11:59 p.m.) to Monday, April 20, 2026 (3:00 a.m.)*

*Dates may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.




Figure 1: Map depicting work zone. Not to scale and for illustrative purposes only. Metrolinx image.

WHAT IS HAPPENING

As part of early work for the future St. Clair-Old Weston Station, crews will be working in the Kitchener rail corridor to complete important track diversion activities. This work block includes rail upgrades, ballast installation, track destressing, temporary construction barrier relocation, and drainage installation along the rail corridor.

There is also the possibility of some excavation and caisson (drilling) work on-site.

Work will take place during a weekend pause in service of the Kitchener line, allowing crews to work safely and continuously day into night from 11:59 p.m. on Friday, April 17, 2026, to Monday, April 20, 2026, at 3:00 a.m.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Activities may include:
 - Upgrading of existing track rails
 - Track destressing
 - Installation of ballast (track level gravel)
 - Relocating temporary construction barriers
 - In-corridor drainage installation
 - Ongoing geotechnical monitoring
 - In-corridor vegetation removals
 - Excavation and caisson drilling
- All work will occur within the rail corridor. Staff will use designated access routes to navigate through the work zone.
- Crews will use heavy machinery, loaders, excavators, and other construction equipment to complete the work.
- Noise, vibrations, dust, and site lighting are expected during this work. Crews will take steps to reduce disturbances as needed, including:
 - Using methods to control dust, light, and noise.
 - Pointing lights away from residential windows and public spaces.
 - No idling of non-essential equipment. Vehicles and equipment will be equipped with white noise alarms.
 - Dust generation will be minimal. Crews will use water as needed to minimize any dust impacts.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Construction vehicles may periodically use Nashville Avenue, Union Street, and Townsley Street to enter and exit the rail corridor.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites and vehicles.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- GO train service will be paused on the Kitchener line from the night of April 17 until the morning of April 20, 2026.

WORK HOURS

- The track closure and construction activities will take place from Friday, April 17 at 11:59 p.m., to Monday, April 20, 2026, at 3:00 a.m.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Metrolinx has a dedicated community engagement team that works with residents and businesses in the Toronto West area.
