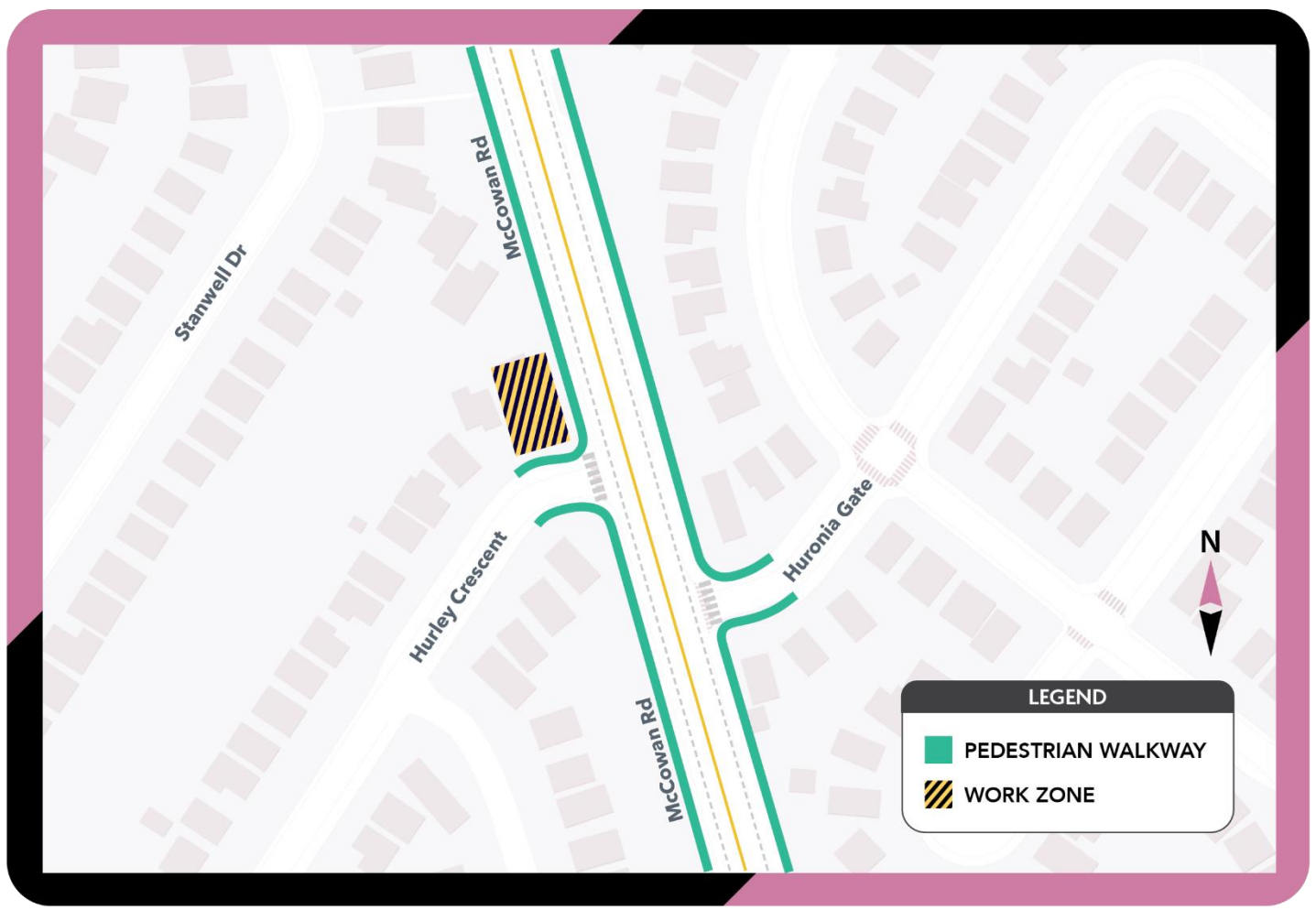


Building demolition at 1072 McCowan Road

Schedule: Monday, March 30 - Friday, April 17, 2026

Hours of Work: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., weekdays

Note: Dates may be impacted due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.



What is Happening

- As part of Scarborough Subway Extension construction, crews will be demolishing the building at 1072 McCowan Road to prepare for construction of a new emergency exit building for the Scarborough Subway Extension. These buildings are spaced between stations to provide exits for riders and access for first responders in the event of an emergency.

What to Expect

- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Demolition will be carried out using a staged approach, designed to maintain structural stability at all times, with controlled removal methods and active debris containment to prevent uncontrolled collapse and ensure public safety throughout the work.
- Residents and nearby businesses may notice an increase in dump trucks and heavy machinery in the area and may hear construction and demolition noise.
- Trucking routes have been established to keep construction vehicles out of residential neighbourhoods.
- Crews will be monitoring the activity and will take steps to minimize noise where possible.
- To minimize the impact to the nearby area, the following measures will be or have been implemented:
 - Dust suppression measures, such as dust screens on site fencing and water suppression.
 - Measures to protect neighbouring structures, trees, utilities and municipal infrastructure.
 - Measures to maintain site cleanliness and minimize impacts to surrounding properties.
- The site will be left in a clean and safe condition at the end of each work shift.
- There will be no impact to pedestrian sidewalks or roadways as a result of this work.

About the Project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
