

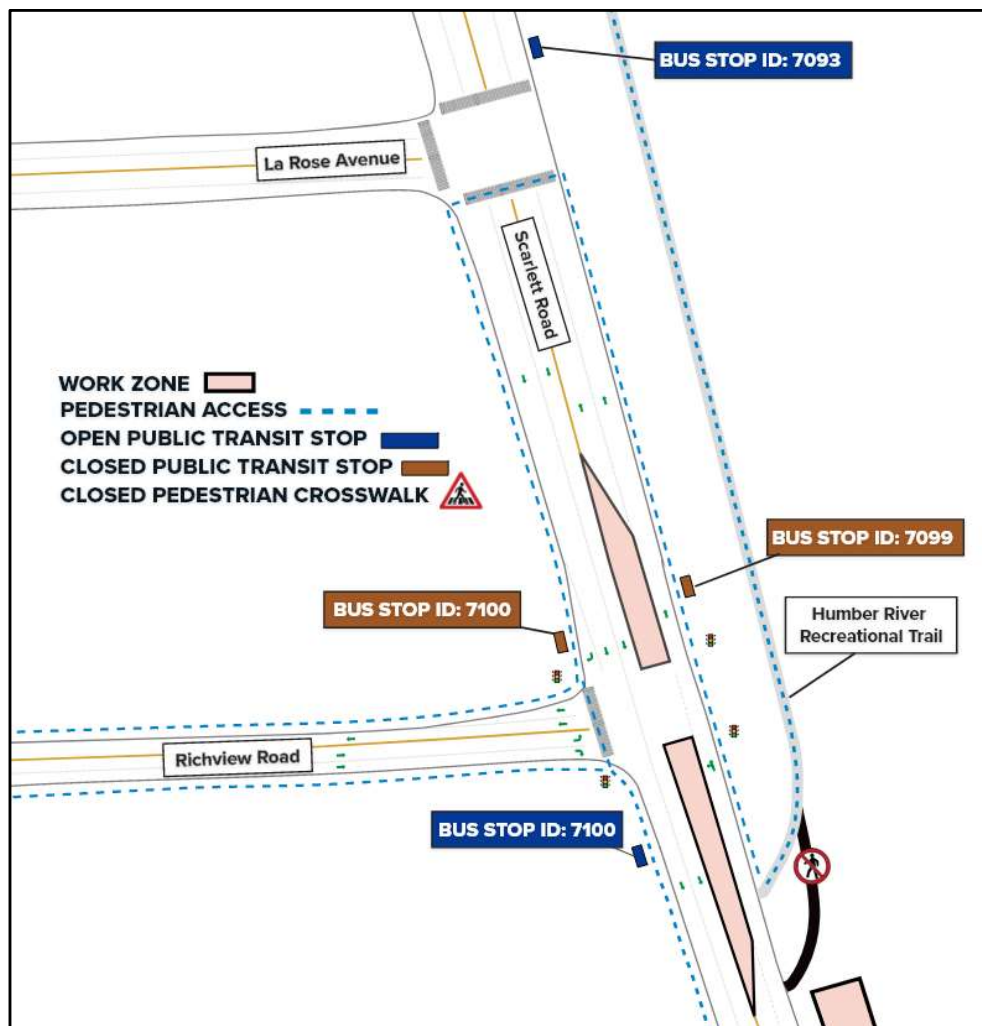
Richview Road traffic light installation

Expected start: April 13, 2026

Expected completion: July 2026

Work hours: Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will begin installing traffic lights at the intersection of Richview Road and Scarlett Road.
- This work will impact northbound and southbound traffic on Scarlett Road north of Eglinton Avenue West.

What to expect

- Access onto Richview will be maintained throughout installation of the traffic lights.
- Temporary lane closures at the Richview Road and Scarlett Road intersection will be in place during work hours.
- Sections of the sidewalks on both the east and west side of Scarlett Road will remain open during this work.
- Sidewalks on the north and south side of Richview Road will remain open.
- Bus shelter ID#7099 will be temporarily closed for the duration of this work; northbound transit users will be able to use bus shelter ID#7093 north of La Rose Avenue.
- Bus shelter ID#7100 will be temporarily relocated to the southwest corner of Scarlett and Richview Road.
- Pedestrians will be able to cross Scarlett Road at the intersection of La Rose Avenue and Scarlett Road.
- The Humber River Recreational Trail located on the east side of Scarlett Road will remain open.
- Detours will be clearly marked with signage and flaggers will be employed as needed to keep vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians moving safely.

- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Weekend work may be required as needed.
- Work is subject to permit approval from the City of Toronto.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of Line 5 Eglinton will run 9.2 kilometers from Mount Dennis Station to Renforth Drive. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
