

Barrie Rail Corridor Improvements: In-corridor construction activities

*Dates are subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

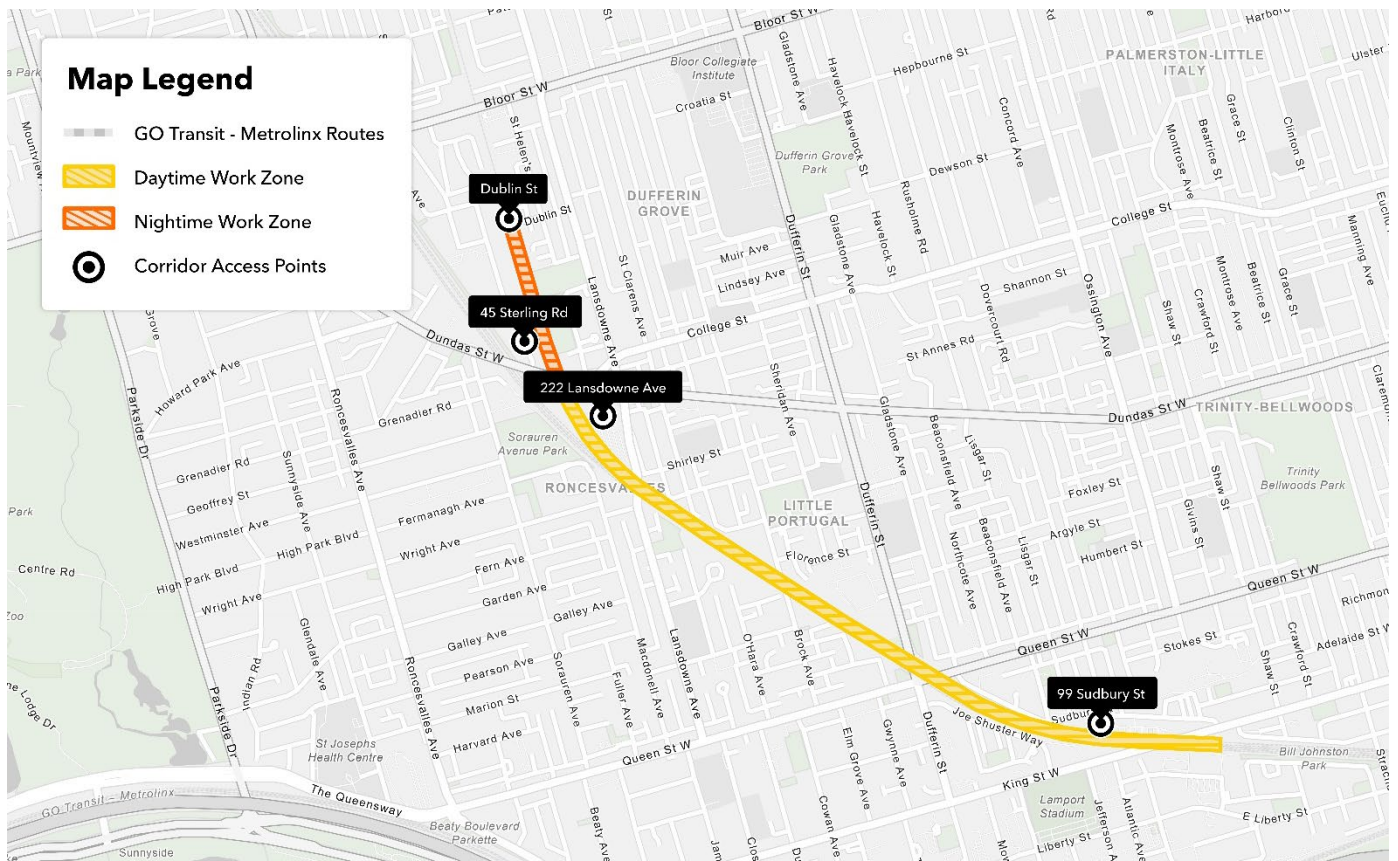


Figure 1: Map indicating approximate work zone. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

WHAT IS HAPPENING

As part of advancements being made to the Barrie line, Metrolinx will be working within the rail corridor between Sudbury Street and Dublin Street to conduct various construction activities, including (but not limited to) drilling, foundation and drainage works, grading, landscaping, excavations, construction of a noise wall, and utility and concrete works (see Figure 1). These activities will be starting in April and will continue through the summer until the end of August. These works are in support of important new infrastructure for the Barrie rail line, including the future second track and upcoming Multi-Use Path.

Activities south of Dundas St. West will be conducted during daytime hours between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Works north of Dundas will be conducted at night between 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

We thank you for your patience as we work to bring you better and faster service along the Barrie line.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Activities at the site will include:
 - Drilling, excavations, and grading
 - Foundation, concrete, and drainage work
 - Other work as needed
 - Equipment to be used include an excavator, loader, crane, compactor, drill rigs, and dump trucks.
- *Noise, dust, and vibration*: There may be some impacts related to noise, dust, and vibration during this work. Metrolinx will utilize noise and vibration monitors to ensure activities remain within acceptable limits.
- *Light*: During overnight work, lighting will be directed at the work zone to minimize light pollution to residents in the surrounding area.
- Metrolinx will implement all reasonable measures to mitigate impacts to nearby residents.
- If any blocks of work are deemed more impactful, the community will be informed via a separate notice.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work south of Dundas St. West will take place Monday to Friday between 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Activities taking place north of Dundas will occur during nighttime hours from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will occur within the Barrie rail corridor between Sudbury Street and Dublin Street.
- Workers will be accessing the site from 4 points along the corridor (see Figure 1):
 - 99 Sudbury Street
 - 222 Lansdowne
 - 45 Sterling Road
 - 11 Dublin Street

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- No sidewalks or pedestrian pathways will be impacted.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be no traffic impacts during this work.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- Work will not impact GO or TTC service.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT
