

Two overnight equipment deliveries at De Grassi Street and Queen St. East

Expected start date: As early as **April 17, 2026** (Deliveries will occur on two nights only)

Hours of work: Between **11 p.m. to 7 a.m.**

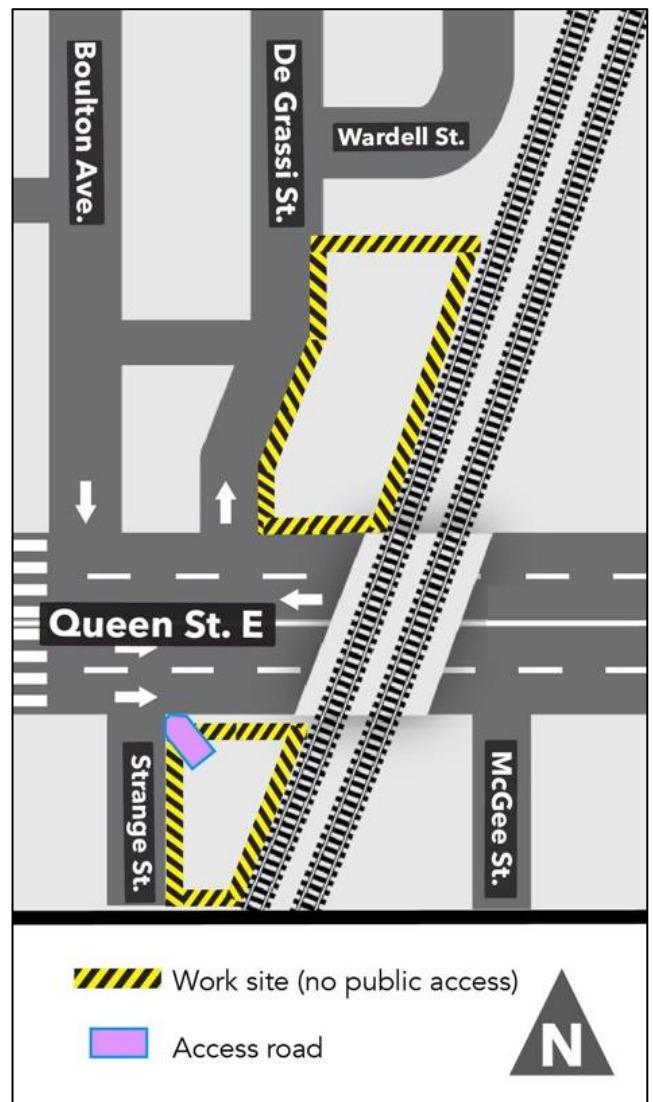
What is happening?

- To facilitate construction of the Riverside-Leslieville Station, large, specialized drilling and crane equipment must be delivered to the worksite.
- The delivery trucks will enter and exit the site through the access road located at the corner of Strange Street and Queen St. East.
- The equipment used is oversized and must be shipped in segments to reduce impacts on local traffic and pedestrians during the day.
- The activity will take **two nights** from **11 p.m. to 7 a.m.** and is expected as early as **April 17, 2026**.
- Flaggers will be onsite to direct trucks in and out of the site.
- Traffic control personnel will also be on-site to safely direct motorists and pedestrians.

What to expect

- Intermittent motorist delays and sidewalk closures are expected during deliveries into the work site.
- All work areas will be fenced off from the public.
- Noise from trucks can be expected.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
