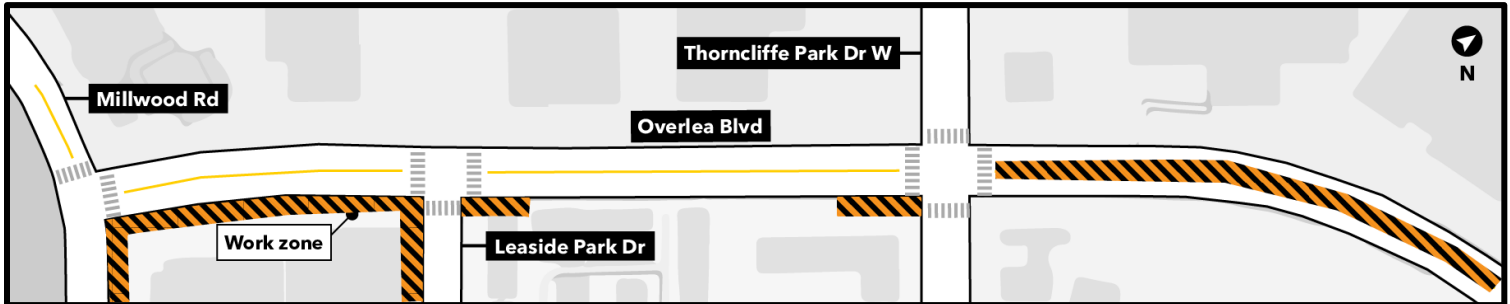


Landscaping along Overlea Boulevard, Millwood Road and Leaside Park Drive

Start Date: As early as Monday, May 4, 2026

Expected Duration: Approximately 3 weeks

Hours of Work: 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.



What is happening?

- As early as Monday, May 4, 2026, landscaping construction will take place along Overlea Blvd. These activities are expected to continue for approximately 3 weeks.
- Metrolinx contractors will begin landscaping construction, including placement of topsoil and sod, tree and shrub planting, along with watering activities, are expected.
- Construction is isolated to the boulevard medians of Millwood Road, Leaside Park Drive and Overlea Boulevard, and the median east of Thorncliffe Park Drive. However, temporary and localised lane closures are expected during construction hours.

What to expect

- Traffic disruptions to accommodate the delivery of planting material, sod, etc. will be minimal and kept to short-term closures.
- Short-term sidewalk closures will be managed by making use of the cycle track adjacent to any landscaping work.
- Traffic control personnel will be present where necessary to assist vehicles and pedestrians.
- Construction may be delayed due to weather conditions and or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
