

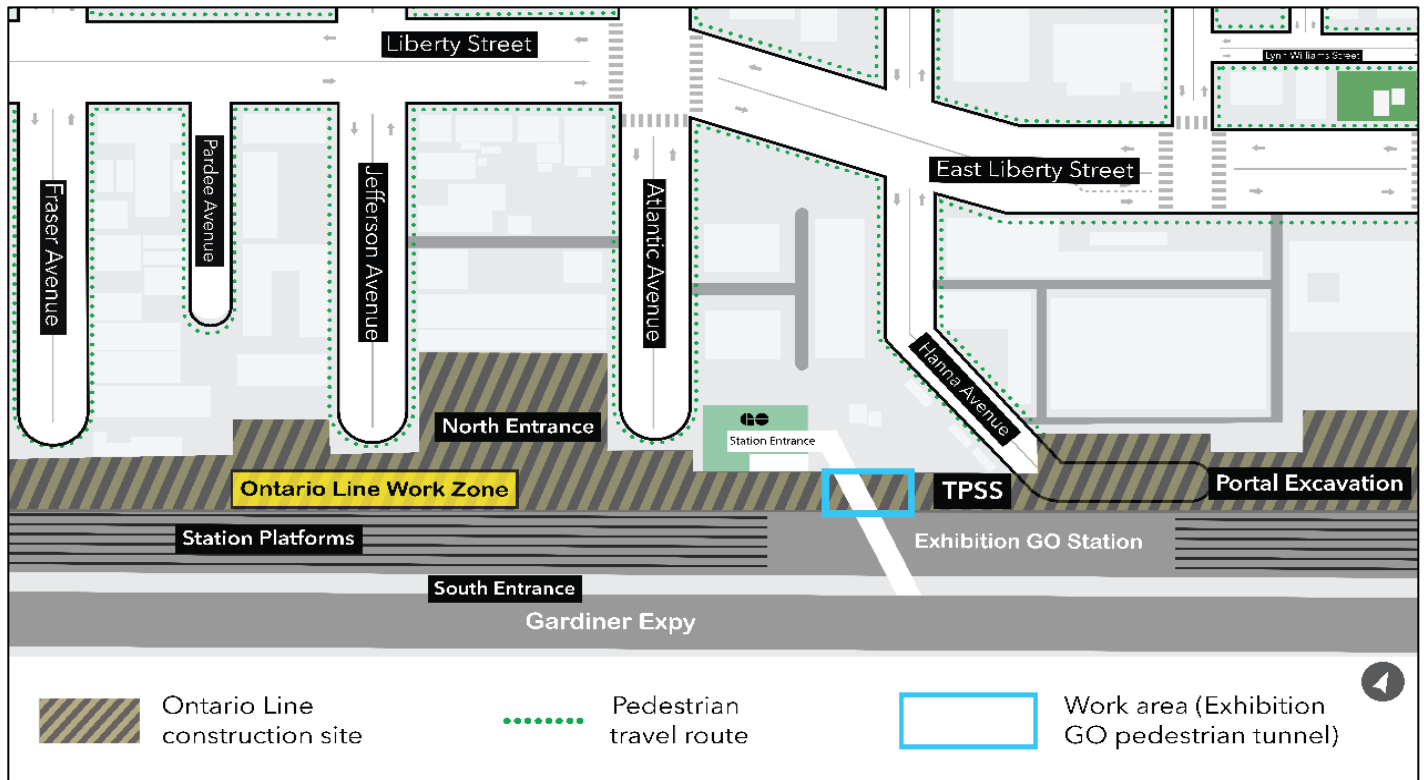
Maintenance connection to Exhibition GO pedestrian tunnel

Expected start date: May 18, 2026

Expected duration of works: May 28, 2026

Hours of work: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

What is happening?

As part of ongoing work to build the future Exhibition Station on the Ontario Line, crews will build a connection from the future Traction Power Substation (TPSS) at the Ontario Line Exhibition construction site to the existing Exhibition GO Station pedestrian tunnel.

This work requires demolition of a portion of the existing tunnel walls to create a maintenance connection to the TPSS, which will supply power to the future Ontario Line subway. Hoarding will be installed around the work area, with directional signage.

What to expect

- Work will take place as early as May 18, 2026, up until May 28, 2026, during weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Crews may be on-site before 7 a.m. to set up equipment.
- Transit users can expect to see and hear machinery and equipment such as skid steers, excavators, and concrete saws.
- Impacts to local water service for residents and businesses are not expected.
- Exhibition GO Station pedestrian tunnel will remain open.
- Work areas will be clearly marked and fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.

- 28,000 fewer car trips on the road each day.
