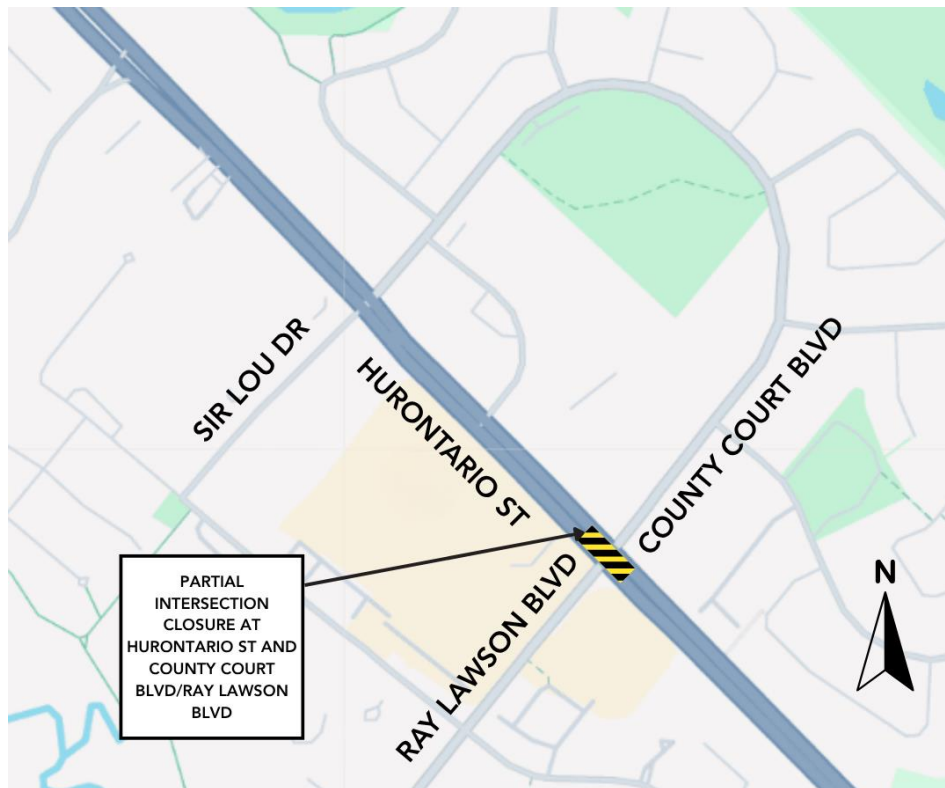


Partial Intersection Closure at Hurontario Street and Ray Lawson Boulevard/County Court Boulevard for LRT Construction



Project Overview

The Hazel McCallion Line project will be an 18-kilometre, 19-stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal.

What You Need to Know

Turn and lane restrictions will be in place at intersection of Hurontario Street and Ray Lawson Boulevard/County Court Boulevard from May 19, 2026, at 10 p.m. to June 23, 2026, at 7 p.m. There will be an overnight implementation of the closure from May 19, 2026, at 10 p.m. to May 20, 2026, at 4 a.m.

Left turns will be prohibited from Hurontario Street to Ray Lawson Boulevard and County Court Boulevard. East-west traffic will also be prohibited through the intersection. Additional lane closures will be in place occasionally during non-peak hours on Hurontario Street at this intersection to accommodate rail welding, material delivery, concrete pouring and related activities.

Crews will be:

- Excavating and installing watermain infrastructure.
- Installing overhead catenary system (OCS) pole foundation & pole bases.
- Installing tracks, guideway concrete and curbs
- Asphalt paving.

Detour routes will be in place via Hurontario Street, County Court Boulevard, Sir Lou Drive and Malta Avenue. Traffic control signage and flaggers will be present to safely guide motorists and pedestrians around the work area.

In accordance with City of Brampton Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Please see roadway signage for the latest information. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- There will be traffic restrictions at the intersection of Hurontario Street and Ray Lawson Boulevard/County Court Boulevard from May 19, 2026 at 10 p.m. to June 23, 2026 at 7 p.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please follow the posted detour signs.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
- Access for emergency services will be always maintained during these works.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- Route 54 will be detouring during construction.

- Please follow pedestrian detour signage as sidewalks and crosswalks may be closed.
