

Reopening of Indian Valley and Hurontario Intersection

May 27, 2026 at 10 p.m.

Turn Restrictions for Track Installation at Pinetree Way and Hurontario Street

Beginning May 28, 2026 at 10 p.m. to July 2, 2026 at 10 p.m.



Project Overview

The Hazel McCallion Line project will be an 18-kilometre, 19-stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal.

What You Need to Know

The Indian Valley Trail/Pinewood Trail intersection works will be completed and it will be reopened on May 27, 2026 as a new signalized intersection. All turning movements, including u-turns, will be permitted after the reopening.

Beginning May 28, 2026, crews will be starting track installation work on the intersection at Hurontario Street and Pinetree Way. During this work, left turns will not be permitted at this intersection. Detours routes will be available via Indian Valley Trail and Glenburnie Road. Additionally, midblock access to Hurontario Street from Hampshire Crescent will be closed as of June 1. Access to

and from Hampshire Crescent becomes right-in, right-out.

Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure. Transit services will be impacted by these construction works. Please visit www.miway.ca/updates for updates on your bus route.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TIMING

- The Indian Valley Trail/Pinewood Trail signalized intersection will be reopened on May 27, 2026.
- Intersection work at Pinetree Way is scheduled to begin May 28, 2026, and continue until July 2, 2026.
- Construction can be scheduled to take place 24/7, Monday through Sunday.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Left turns at the intersection of Hurontario Street and Pinetree Way will be restricted.
- Detour routes will be available via Indian Valley Trail and Glenburnie Road.
- Access to and from Hampshire Crescent will be right-in, right out as of June 1, 2026
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
