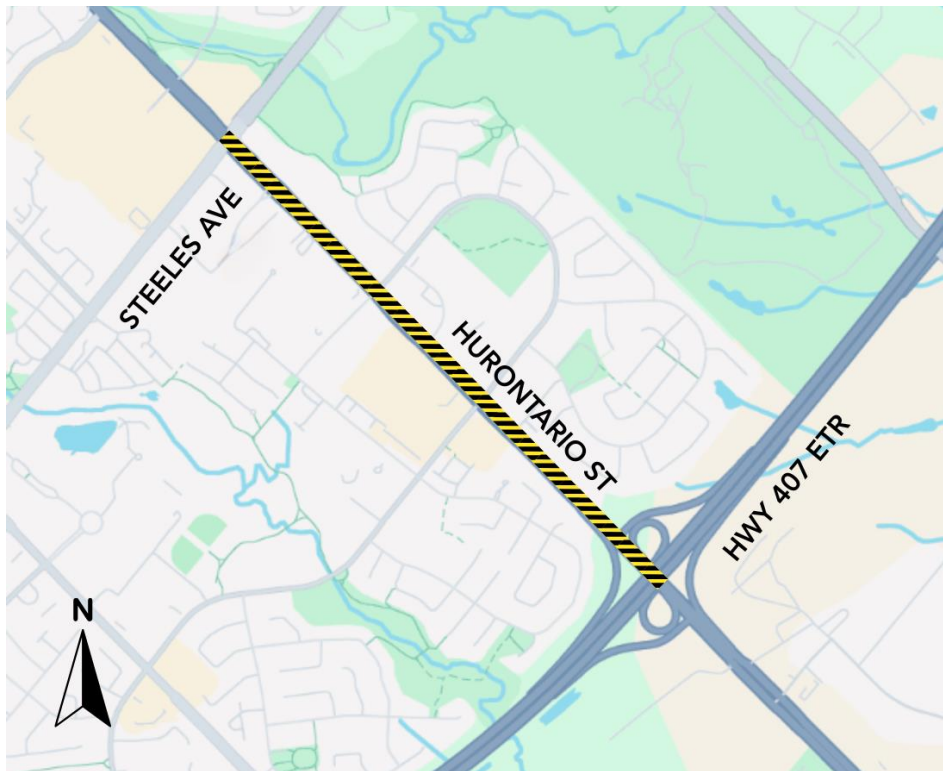


Nighttime track work on Hurontario Street from Highway 407 ETR to Steeles Avenue

Intermittently from June 1, 2026 to End of Summer, 2026 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.



Project Overview

The Hazel McCallion Line project will be an 18-kilometre, 19-stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal.

What You Need to Know

Crews will be conducting track destressing works on Hurontario Street between Highway 407 ETR to Steeles Avenue.

These works will be done overnight from June 1 and end of summer, 2026 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. in various areas along this segment.

Information as of: June 2026

This work is being scheduled intermittently overnight to complete the work as quickly as possible.

In accordance with City of Brampton Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TIMING

- Overnight track work will be happening intermittently from June 1 to End of Summer, 2026.
- Working hours are from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require property access for this work.
