

## Scarborough Subway Extension Construction Liaison Committee - Expression of Interest Information Package

*Join our Construction Liaison Committee!*

### **Introduction**

Metrolinx is launching a Construction Liaison Committee (CLC) for the Scarborough Subway Extension project, to improve how we engage with the community during construction. We are creating one Scarborough-wide committee to bring all voices together. This “One Scarborough” approach will foster positive communication, collaboration, and trust between Metrolinx and the community.

The CLC will meet quarterly and serve as a forum for two-way dialogue where members will receive project updates and can share community feedback directly to the project team. The goal is to ensure we continue to understand and reflect the needs and concerns of Scarborough residents and businesses for the duration of the project’s construction.

### **Committee purpose**

- Discuss progress and plans for the Scarborough Subway Extension.
- Identify and address community concerns related to topics affecting the project as a whole (such as long-term planning, community benefits, business supports, managing traffic during construction at all active sites, community events, as well as hoarding art).
- Share ideas to maximize the benefits of the project for local residents and businesses.
- Ensure that Metrolinx is aware of on-the-ground issues and that the community stays informed about project developments.

The CLC is complementary to Construction Impact Tables (CITs), which is where immediate local construction issues (such as construction noise and vibration, dust, local traffic changes, and safety barriers) will be addressed.

### **Benefits of joining the CLC**

As a CLC member, you will:

- Have a direct line to the project team, learn about the latest updates, and have the opportunity to ask questions directly to project staff and subject matter experts.

- Influence decisions by providing your feedback and ideas directly to project team members.
- Be a community champion as you represent your neighborhood or group and help us make sure no part of Scarborough is overlooked.
- Build your network by being connected to other active community members, local leaders, and project staff who are all working together for Scarborough.

## **Member and staff responsibilities and support:**

As a CLC member, your responsibilities will include:

- Attending and actively participating in quarterly CLC meetings.
- Preparing for meetings by reading any materials in advance (we'll provide agendas and information beforehand).
- Sharing insights from your community and respectfully listening to others' input.
- Helping to communicate key information back to your community (for instance, letting your neighbours or colleagues know about opportunities to engage with our Community Engagement team).

In return, Metrolinx will support you by:

- Providing orientation and support for new members, so you fully understand the project and your role.
- Offering accommodations (like accessibility support and translation services) to ensure everyone can participate equally.
- Being available between meetings through our Community Engagement staff who will be your point of contact for any questions or ideas you want to share.

## **Who should apply?**

We're looking for a diverse group of members who reflect Scarborough. You should apply if you:

- **Have a connection to Scarborough!**  
You live, work, or own a business in the areas affected by the subway extension. Local knowledge and lived experience in Scarborough are important.
- **Care about your community and transit.**  
You're passionate about community development, improving public transit, or simply making Scarborough an even better place to live. (You don't need to be a transit expert - all you need is an interest in the community's well-being.)
- **Can commit time and participate actively.**  
You're able to attend four meetings per year (approximately two hours each, some in-person and some virtual) and engage in email/phone updates between meetings if required.

- **Bring a unique perspective or skill.**

Perhaps you're active in a local community group, or you have experience advocating for your neighborhood, or you belong to a community that hasn't had a voice in projects like this before. We value **lived experience** and **fresh ideas**, whether you're a student, senior, business owner, newcomer or longtime resident.

## **Application and selection process**

1. **Application**

Fill out the online Expression of Interest application survey by **July 12, 2026**. In the survey, we'll ask for some information about you, including your connection to Scarborough and why you're interested.

2. **Review**

All applications will be reviewed by a Metrolinx selection panel. We will be assessing applications based on how you meet the criteria mentioned above (things like your community involvement, perspectives you bring, and commitment to the project's goals). Our goal is to assemble a balanced group representing different areas and communities in Scarborough.

3. **Selection**

We anticipate selecting approximately 15 members for the CLC. Successful applicants will be contacted by mid-August, 2026. If you're not selected, we will also notify you and keep you informed about other ways to stay involved.

4. **First meeting**

The **first CLC meeting is expected to take place in person in September 2026**. We will provide an orientation for members at that time. All details (exact date and location) will be communicated well in advance.
