

WHAT ARE UP EXPRESS, GO TRANSIT AND PRESTO?

UP PRESTO

UP Express

- A dedicated express train connecting Toronto Pearson Airport (YYZ) to downtown Toronto's Union Station, where you can then take GO Transit to Toronto Stadium.
- Trips from YYZ to Union take just 28 minutes.
- Trains every 15 minutes.
- Follow the "Train to City" signage at Pearson Airport to find UP Express.



GO Transit

- Green-and-white-coloured train and bus service that connects Toronto with the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA).
- Links major cities and suburbs to Toronto's Union Station.
- Useful for visitors travelling between Toronto and surrounding regions, including Niagara Falls.



PRESTO

- The fare payment system for transit across Toronto and the GTHA.
- PRESTO cards are available as both physical cards and digitally in Apple/Google Wallet.
- Tap and pay with an Interac® Debit card, credit card or mobile wallet on any PRESTO payment device.

Keep this brochure to help you travel easily on public transit.

TAPPING ON AND OFF

- When using GO Transit or UP Express, pay your fare by tapping on a PRESTO device before you board your train. When you arrive at your destination, tap off at the station to pay the correct fare.
- When tapping off, remember to use the same physical or digital PRESTO payment (PRESTO card, credit, Interac® Debit or mobile wallet).
- Your tapped card is your proof of payment. Be ready to show it when requested.
- Tapping off is not required on TTC and other local transit services.



PRESTO Contactless

Visitors can tap a credit card, Interac® Debit card or mobile wallet directly on PRESTO payment devices. No card purchase is needed.

HOW TO GET TO TORONTO STADIUM

- Use GO Transit or local transit such as the TTC to get to Union Station.
- From Union Station, take GO Transit's Lakeshore West Line to Exhibition GO Station.
- Walk south from Exhibition GO to Toronto Stadium.



WHERE TO BUY THE PRESTO COMMEMORATIVE CARD



Buy a Limited Edition PRESTO card for \$4 at select Ticket Vending Machines at Pearson Airport, Union Station, Bloor and Yonge stations, and Exhibition GO Station. The commemorative card works like a regular PRESTO card to pay your fare, while featuring a limited-edition collector design.

SAFETY, ACCESSIBILITY AND ETIQUETTE TIPS

SAFETY

- Spread out along the platform to avoid overcrowding.
- Stand behind the yellow line.
- Don't cross the train tracks.
- For safety or security concerns, text "HELP" to 77777 (not available to international carriers).
- For international cell phone plan users, please call our GO Transit Security Dispatch at 1-877-297-0642.

ACCESSIBILITY

- GO station accessibility features include ramps, elevators and barrier-free parking.
- The accessibility coach is located near the middle of the train and features step-free boarding, an accessible washroom and a Customer Service Ambassador.
- All GO buses offer accessible seating.

ETIQUETTE

- No feet or bags on seats.
- Dispose of garbage or take it with you.
- No alcohol, vaping or smoking on trains, buses or in stations.



HOW TO GET TO THE FIFA FAN FESTIVAL™ TORONTO

- Take GO Transit or local transit such as the TTC to get to Union Station.
- From Union Station, it's about a 30-minute walk to the FIFA Fan Festival Toronto™ located at Fort York and the Bentway.
