

# De Grassi Street resident parking available at 356 Eastern Avenue

Parking available as of: June 22, 2026

## What is happening?

In order to begin major construction for the future Leslieville Station, crews will expand the work area into one lane on De Grassi Street. This will reduce the amount of street parking available. If residents cannot attain parking on De Grassi Street, six additional parking spaces are available at **356 Eastern Avenue, accessible via the south end of Saulter Street (12 Saulter Street)**. De Grassi St residents are not permitted to park in parking spots that are reserved for Fontbonne Place.

## What to expect

- Construction hoarding will be moved onto one lane into De Grassi Street.
- Vehicles will still be able to travel through De Grassi Street without impediment.

## Traffic Changes

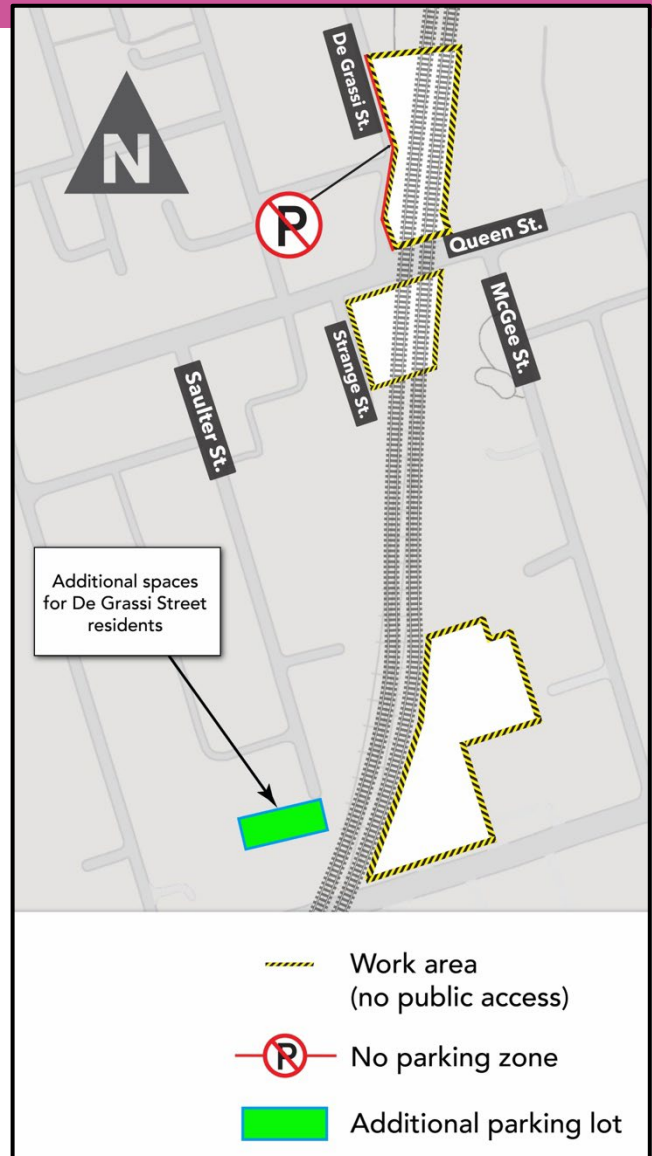
- Minor delays may be experienced near the work zone.
- A paid duty officer, flaggers and detour signs will be onsite to direct traffic as needed.
- All businesses in the area will remain open during the work. Please follow signage for access.

## Pedestrian Access

- Pedestrian detours may be required, with signs in place to direct pedestrians as needed.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

## Transit Service

- There is no anticipated impact to transit services.



## About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
