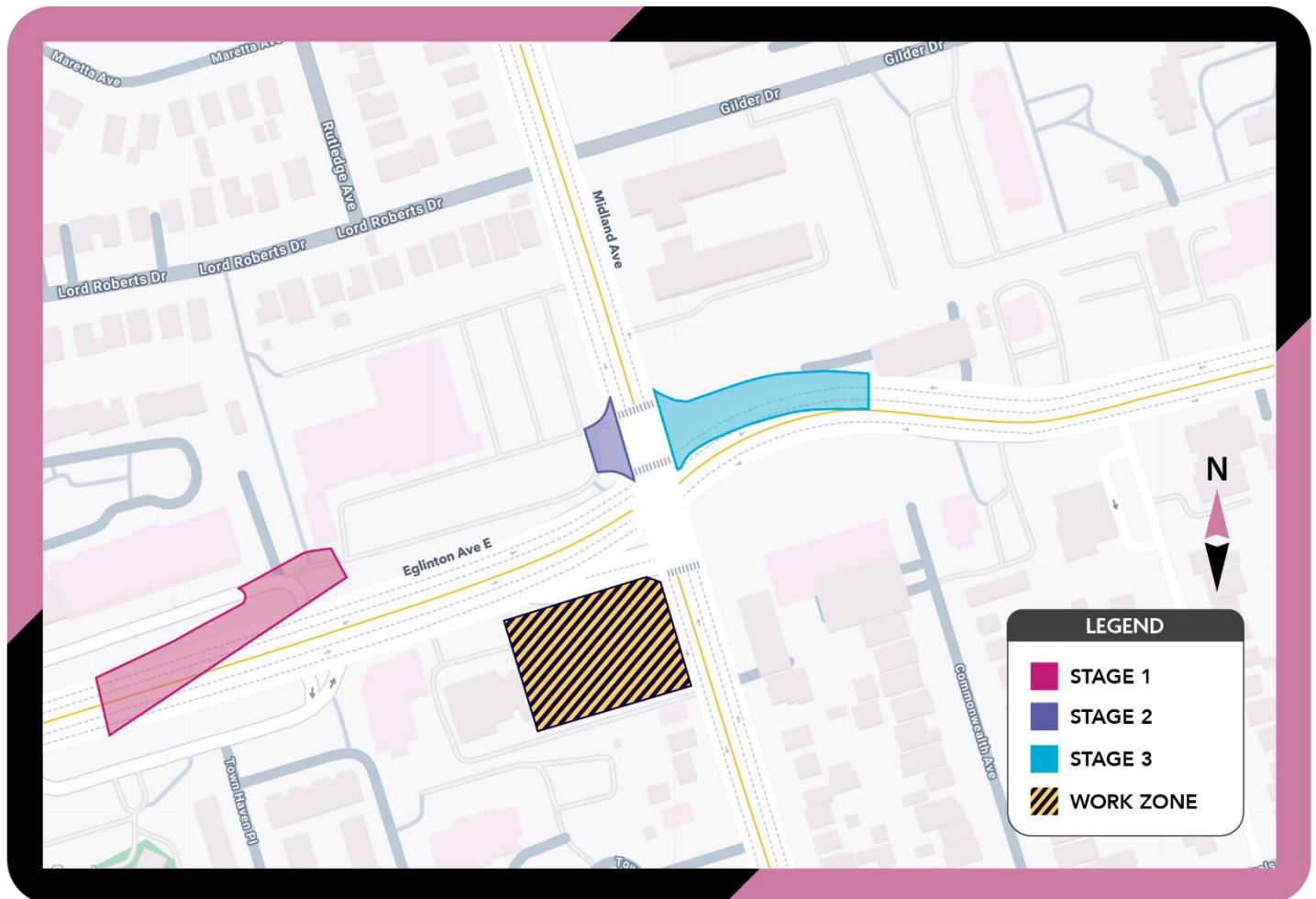


# Lane closures on Eglinton Avenue East

**Schedule:** May 13 – July 2, 2026

**Hours of Work:** 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. weekdays



## What is Happening

- As part of Scarborough Subway Extension construction, Eglinton Avenue East will be diverted to the north to allow for the construction that will connect the existing Kennedy station subway tunnel with the extension's tunnel boring machine extraction shaft at Eglinton Avenue East and Midland Avenue.
- To prepare for this diversion crews will be performing roadway and sidewalk construction on Eglinton Avenue East between the Eglinton Avenue overpass and Commonwealth Ave and on Midland Avenue, just north of the Eglinton Avenue East intersection.
- This work will be completed in three stages, starting May 13.

## What to Expect

### General

- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

### Traffic

- Minor delays may be experienced near the work zone.
- Westbound and eastbound lanes on Eglinton Avenue East, and northbound and southbound lanes on Midland Avenue, will be reduced for periods of time during the work. Signage will redirect traffic around the work zones.
- Two-way directional traffic will be maintained during the work.
- Traffic flaggers and/or paid duty officers will also be present to ensure pedestrian, driver and worker safety.
- All businesses in the area will remain open during the work.

### Transit Services

- There is no anticipated impact to transit services.

### Noise and Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area can expect noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.

### Pedestrian Access

- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

## About the Project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
