

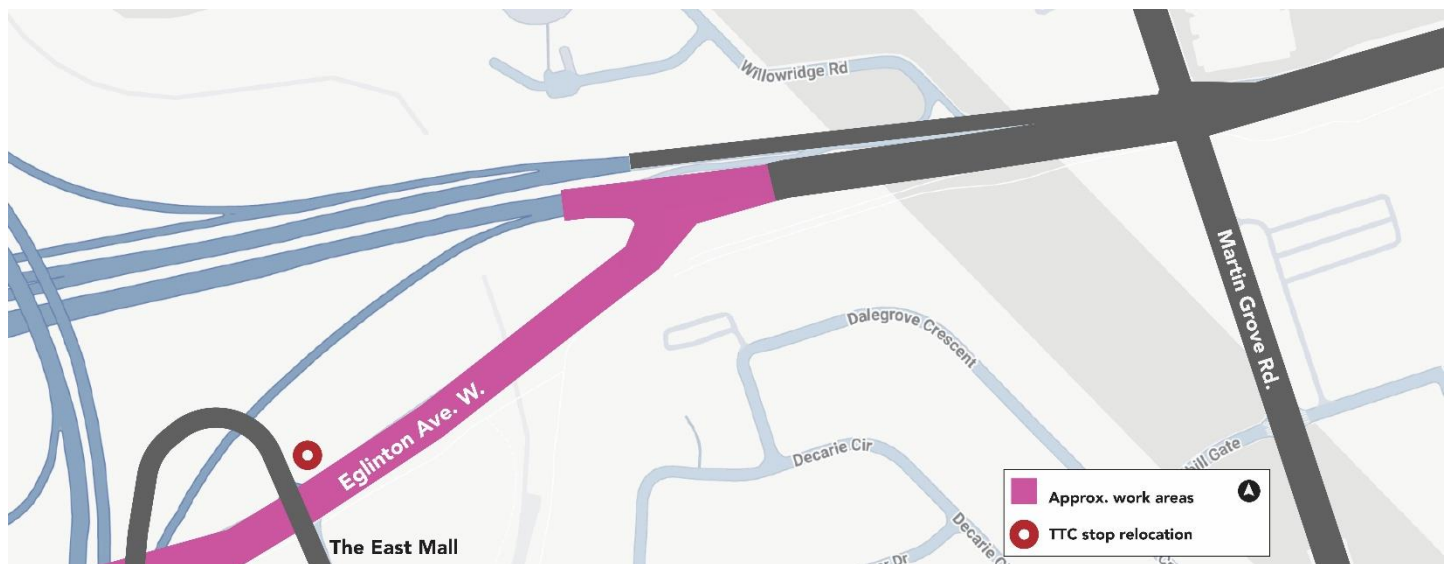
Utility Investigation work on Eglinton Avenue West between Martin Grove Road and Commerce Boulevard

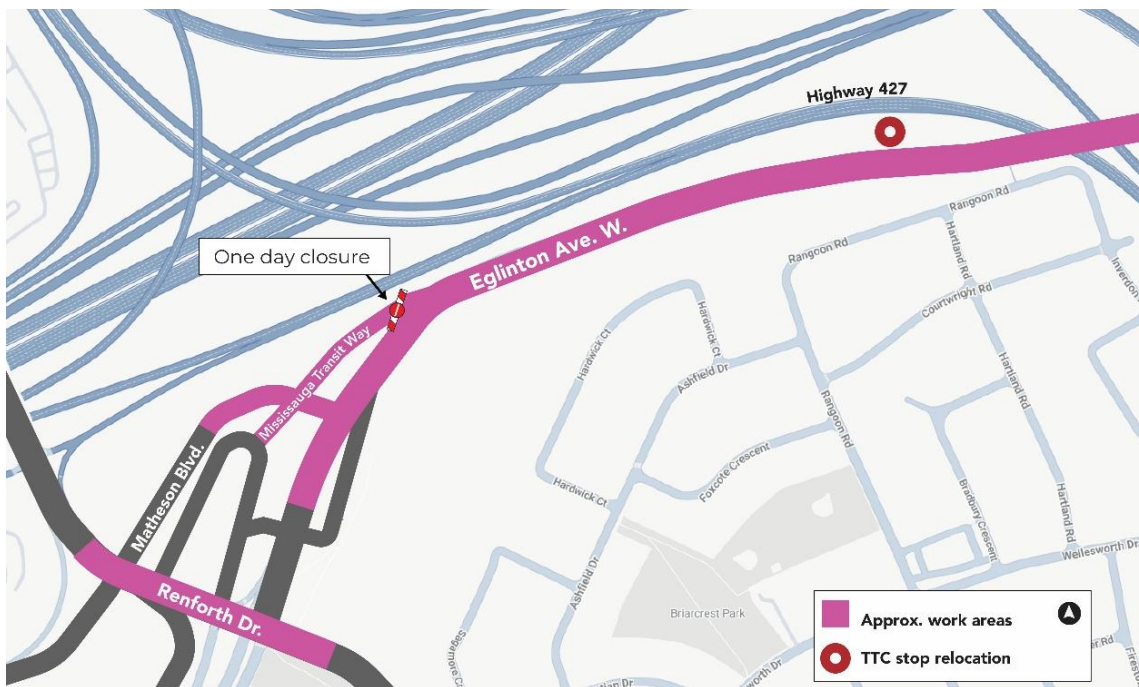
Expected start: July 15, 2026

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What is happening?

- Crews will be conducting subsurface utility investigations on and in the vicinity Eglinton Avenue West from Martin Grove Road to Commerce Boulevard.
- This work is required to gather information about existing underground infrastructure to support the design of the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension.
- Activities will include small test pits to confirm the location and depth of underground utilities, inspections of existing manholes and catch basins, and closed-circuit television (CCTV) inspections of underground sewer and stormwater pipes.

Traffic and transit details

- Minor traffic lane and sidewalk closures will occur within the work areas highlighted on the maps above.
- Closures at each location will last approximately one - two days.
- Traffic lanes and sidewalks are expected to reopen at the end of each workday.
- Traffic control personnel and Paid Duty Officers will be present to assist drivers and pedestrians.
- TTC and MiWay bus stop relocations will take place at the following locations:
 - Eglinton Avenue at The East Mall
 - Eglinton Avenue West at Opposite Walkway to Rangoon Road
 - Commerce Boulevard at Renforth Station

- The Mississauga Transit Way will be closed at Eglinton Avenue on Monday, July 20, 2026, to safely facilitate these investigations.

What to expect

- This work will involve survey equipment, utility investigation vehicles, vacuum excavation trucks, and CCTV inspection equipment.
- Residents and businesses may notice investigation crews, utility vehicles, temporary lane restrictions, and intermittent noise from construction equipment. Traffic control measures will be in place where required to maintain the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians.

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- Investigation activities will occur at various locations and will be completed in phases. Following completion of the work, all areas will be restored to existing or better condition in accordance with municipal requirements.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Overnight or weekend work may be scheduled as needed.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of Line 5 Eglinton will run 9.2 kilometers from Mount Dennis Station to Renforth Drive. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.

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
