

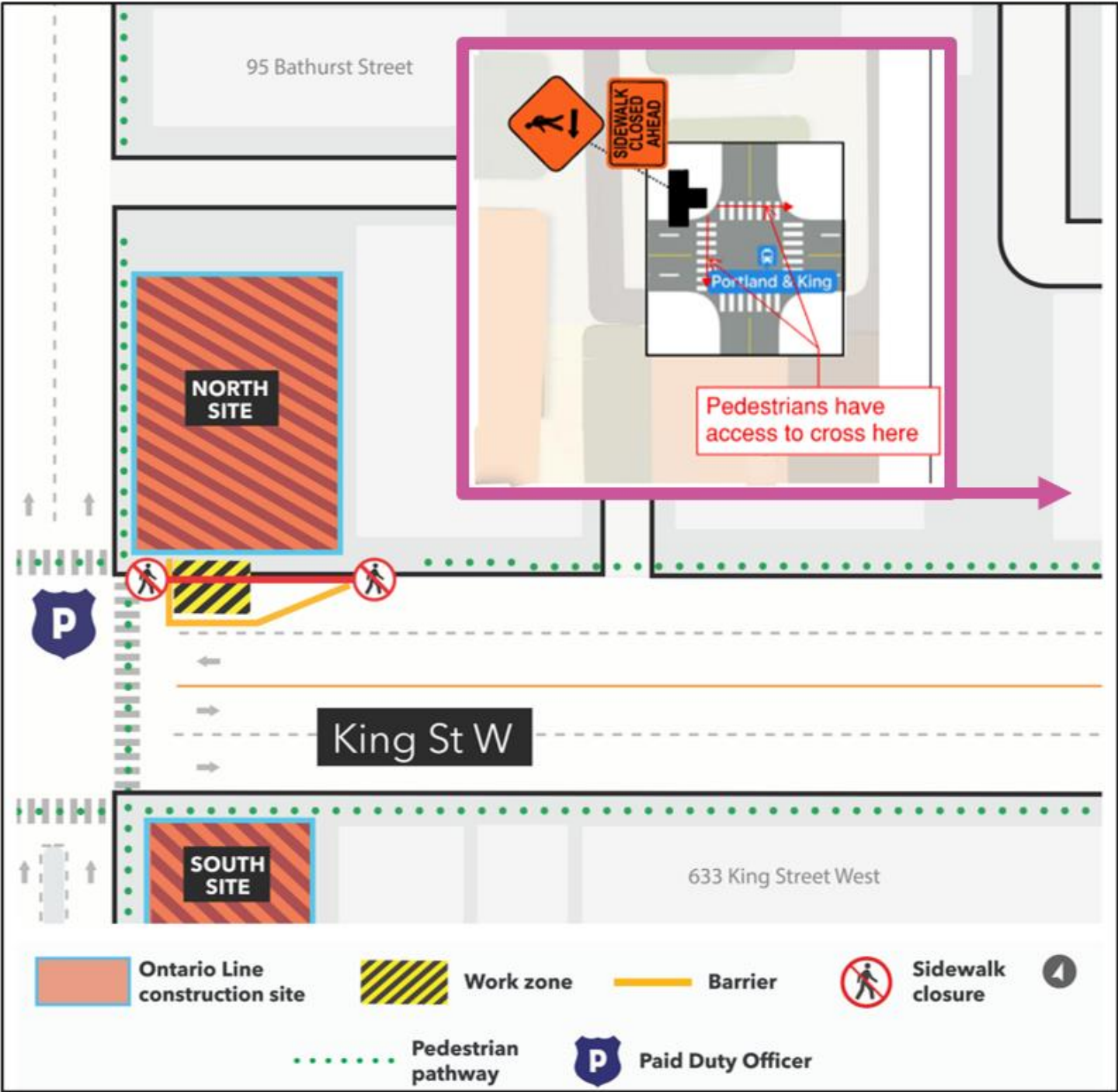
Watermain Connections at King West Station

Expected start date: As early as July 22, 2026
Expected end date: Late August 2026
Hours of work: Weekdays, 7:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M.

What is happening?

- Crews are installing watermain utility connections at the King West Ontario Line construction site, as indicated in the area shown in yellow on the map below.
- Temporary sidewalk and lane reductions are required on King Street West at Bathurst Street to complete this work.

What to expect

- Work is scheduled from 7:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. Monday to Friday, starting as early as Wednesday, July 22, 2026.
- The sidewalk on the north side of King Steet West at Bathurst Street (in front of the Ontario Line construction site) will be temporarily closed to conduct this work. Pedestrians will have access to cross the street at Portland Street.
- The westbound curb lane will be closed at King Street West, approaching Bathurst Street, to carry out this work safely.
- Signage will be in place for pedestrian and vehicle traffic.
- A paid duty officer will be present during working hours.
- During the excavation process, crews will use a hydrovac truck and excavator to access existing water lines.
- All construction schedules are subject to change and weather permitting.
- Transit services will be maintained.
- After each work shift, each area will be securely covered and marked for safety until workers return or the work is complete.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
