

Watermain connections at Chinatown Station

Expected start date: As early as July 27, 2026

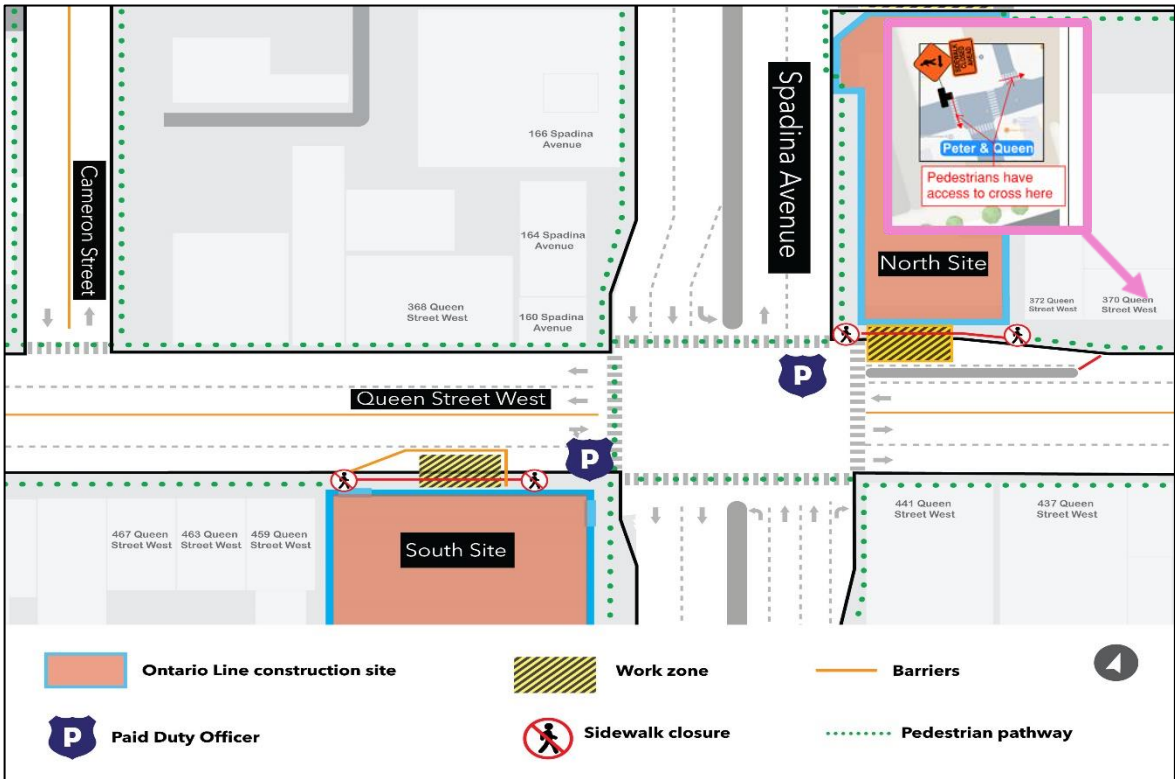
Expected end date: Mid-August 2026

Hours of work: 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday to Friday; occasional work 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., as required

What is happening?

- Crews are installing watermain service to the Ontario Line Chinatown Station construction site, as indicated in the area shown in yellow on the map below.
- Temporary sidewalk and lane reductions are required on Queen Street West to complete this work.

What to expect

- The sidewalk adjacent to the work zone will be closed during overnight work (9 p.m. to 5 a.m.).
- A paid duty officer will be present during overnight working hours.
- Sidewalks will remain open during any daytime work (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.).
- Signage will be posted advising of closures, restrictions and locations for pedestrians to safely cross the street before encountering the work zone.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained or accommodated.
- After each work shift, each area will be securely covered and marked for safety until workers return, or the work is complete.
- During the excavation process, crews will use a hydrovac truck and excavator to access existing water lines. There will be no impacts or disruptions to water services in the area.
- Traffic and transit services will be maintained in all directions.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
