

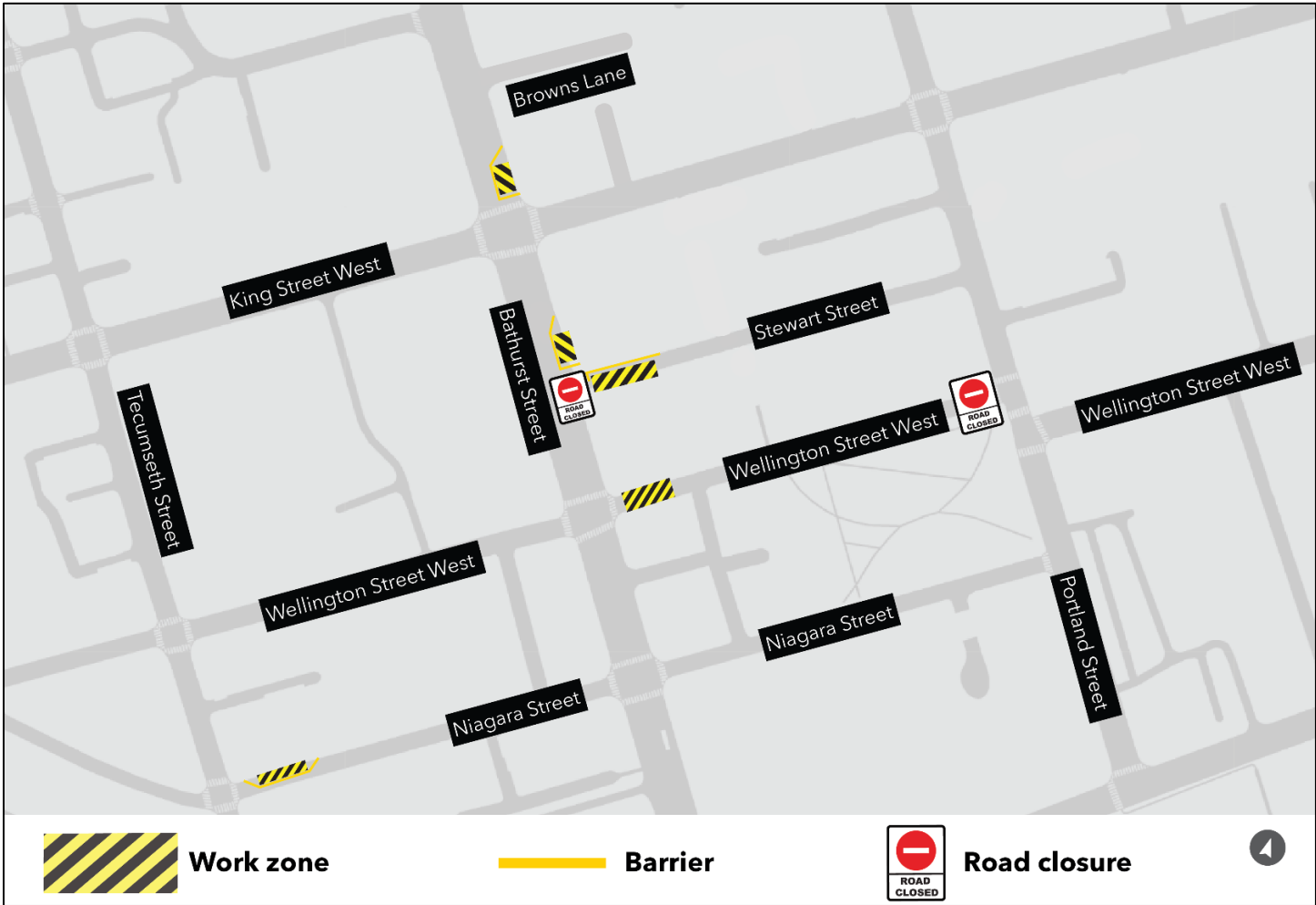
Monitoring Well Decommissioning at King West Station

Expected start date: As early as August 4, 2026
Expected end date: August 7, 2026
Hours of work: 10:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday to Friday

What is happening?

- Crews will decommission multiple monitoring wells in the area around **King West Station** from Niagara Street to Bathurst and Adelaide, as shown in yellow on the map.

What to expect

- The following road closures are anticipated:
 - Wellington Street West between Portland Street and Bathurst Street
 - There will be no access to Stewart Street from Bathurst Street
 - North side of Niagara Street near Tecumseth Street
 - Note:** No parking will be permitted in construction zones.
- Speed limited will be reduced near work sites for worker safety.
- All bike lanes will remain open and on-street parking will be restricted on Wellington Street West.
- After each work shift, each area will be securely covered and marked for safety until workers return or the work is complete.
- A paid duty officer (PDO) will be present during overnight working hours to direct traffic.
- Traffic and transit services will be maintained in all directions.

- Signage will be posted advising of any closures, restrictions and locations for pedestrians to safely cross the street before encountering the work zone.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained or accommodated.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
