

Decommissioning wells in the Chinatown Station area

Expected start date: As early as August 10, 2026
Expected end date: August 14, 2026
Hours of work: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday; overnight at Graffiti Alley from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What is happening?

- Crews will decommission wells in the **Chinatown Station** area as shown in yellow on the map.

What to expect

- The following closures are anticipated:
 - The curb lane on northbound Ryerson Avenue at Queen Street W.
 - The curb lane on northbound Augusta Avenue at Queen Street W.
 - The curb lane on northbound Cameron Street at Queen Street W.
 - Graffiti Alley at Spadina Avenue
- After each work shift, each area will be securely covered and marked for safety until workers return or the work is complete.
- A paid duty officer and flagger will be present at the intersection of Augusta Avenue and Queen Street to direct traffic.
- A flagger will be at the intersection of Cameron Avenue and Queen Street West to direct traffic.
- Traffic and transit services will be maintained in all directions.
- Signage will be posted advising of closures, restrictions and locations for pedestrians to safely cross the street before encountering the work zone.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained or accommodated.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
