

Anchor Pole Relocation at King West Station

Expected start date: As early as August 17, 2026

Expected completion date: August 18, 2026

Hours of work: Weekdays, 7:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.

What is happening?

- Crews will be relocating a pole anchor currently located on the sidewalk on the east side of Bathurst Street, south of King Street West, as indicated in the area indicated with number 1 on the map below.
- Pole anchors are used to secure and stabilize utility poles which carry overhead wires in areas where these utilities are not buried underground.
- Temporary sidewalk closures are required on Bathurst Street to complete this work. Pedestrian diversions will be in place.

What to expect

- Work is scheduled from 7:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. and is expected to start as early as **Monday, August 17, 2026.**
- The sidewalk on the east side of Bathurst Street between King Street West and Stewart Street will be temporarily closed to conduct this work. A pedestrian diversion will be in place near the transit island on Bathurst Street.
- The northbound curb lane on Bathurst Street between Stewart Street and King Street West will be closed to carry out this work safely.
- Signage will be in place for pedestrian and vehicle traffic. A paid duty officer (PDO) will be on site to direct traffic during working hours.
- Residents and businesses can expect to hear noise associated with relocation of utilities along with typical construction operation during working hours.
- All construction schedules are subject to change and weather permitting.
- Transit services will be maintained.
- Outside of work hours, the work site will be securely covered and marked for safety until workers return or the work is complete.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
