

Watermain Work at Moss Park Station

Expected start date: As early as August 17, 2026

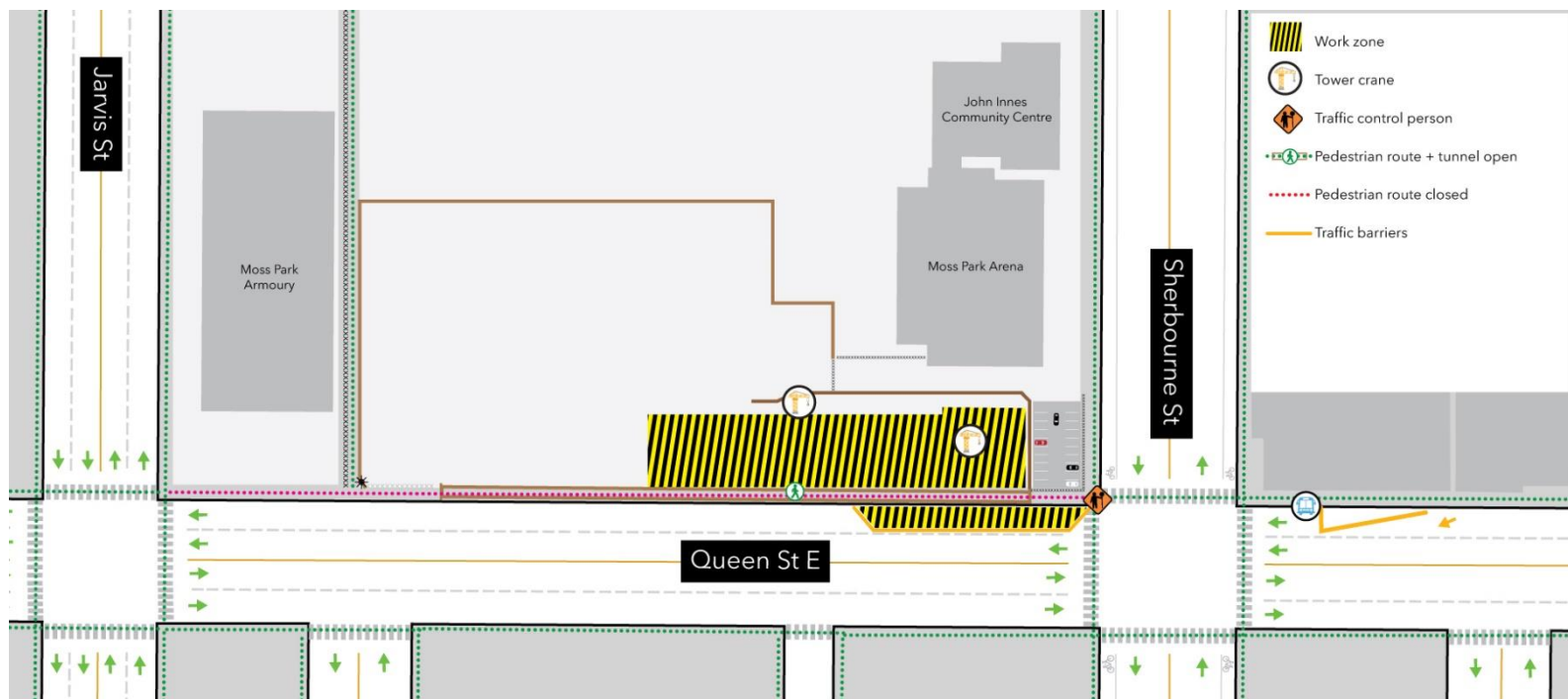
Expected completion date: August 21, 2026

Hours of work: 24-hour work during the work period

What is happening?

- As progress continues of the future Ontario Line Moss Park station, crews will connect the site to the sewer system, remove existing connections where needed, and install the services required to support the future station.

What to expect

- Watermain work and lane closures are scheduled to begin as early as **August 17th**.
- The eastbound curb lane on Queen St E on both sides of Sherbourne St will be closed for the duration of this work. Signage will be in place to direct traffic.
- Temporary pedestrian detours will also be in place during this work, along with signage clearly indicating detours.
- Residents can expect an increased presence of construction vehicles during this work and additional noise from this construction work.

- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety. Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
- Trucks will stage inside the work site and will not stage outside of the site boundaries.
- A paid-duty officer (PDO) will be on-site along with flag personnel to direct traffic.
- Dirt and debris will be dampened, swept and removed.
- All construction schedules are subject to change and weather-permitting.
- Transit services will be maintained.
- Work may be postponed or re-scheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
