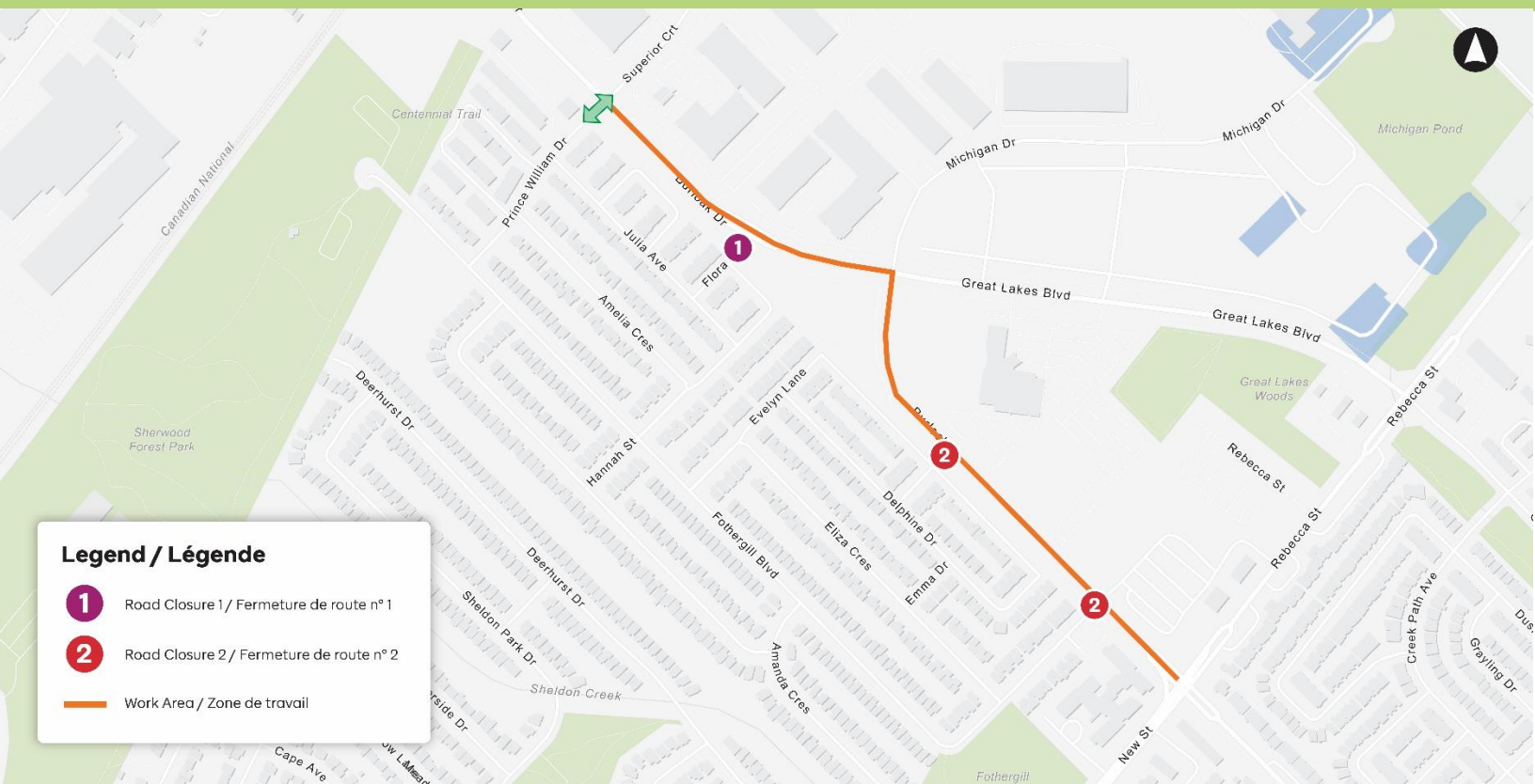


Burloak Drive: Pavement Restoration

August 24-28 2026



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15 minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service.

To support the increase in GO Service, Metrolinx is working with the City of Burlington and the Town of Oakville to build the grade separation (separation of the road from the rail corridor) at Burloak Drive. This work will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety and will optimize traffic flow at this crossing.

WHAT WORK IS TAKING PLACE?

Construction Activity	Scheduled Start Date	Expected Duration	Work Hours	Description of Work
Permanent Pavement Restoration	August 24 - 28	5 days	Daytime work (Monday to Friday, 7am-5pm)	Traffic control and site set up. Crews will be removing the surface layer of the road and replacing it with a new layer of asphalt.
Lane closures (recurring)	Ongoing			Relocation of existing utilities and road widening.
Work durations are approximate, work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.				

WHAT TO EXPECT

From **August 24 to August 28, 2026, crews will be paving Burloak Drive, south of Prince William Drive to New Street.**

Intersection and lane closures will be required along Burloak Drive between New Street and Prince William Drive.

The intersection at Flora Drive and Burloak Drive (shown as 1 on the map) will be temporarily closed for 2-3 days.

The Burloak Drive intersections at Adele Road and Fothergill Boulevard (shown as 2 on the map) will then close after the first section is complete, for 2-3 days, as the work progresses south. Detour route signage will be in place to direct traffic. Please note, these intersections will reopen outside of working hours, please take extra care as road surfaces may be uneven.

Pedestrian sidewalks will remain open.

There will also be recurring short-term lane closures along Burloak Drive between the Rebecca/New Street and Harvester/Wyecroft Road intersections for on-going works

We will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and businesses, including but not limited to the following:

- Ongoing monitoring for noise and dust
- Regular street sweeping
- Mud mats at site exit points to control and prevent dirt transfer from the site onto local roads
- Detour routes identified during intersection closures with required signage
- Limiting construction traffic and no parking on public streets

The restoration will start south of Prince William Drive and Burloak and will proceed south until New Street.

Prince William Drive and Amanda Crescent intersections will remain open throughout the works. During each closure, please use alternative intersections as diversion routes. Please note, the dates are subject to change based on weather or unforeseen issues.
