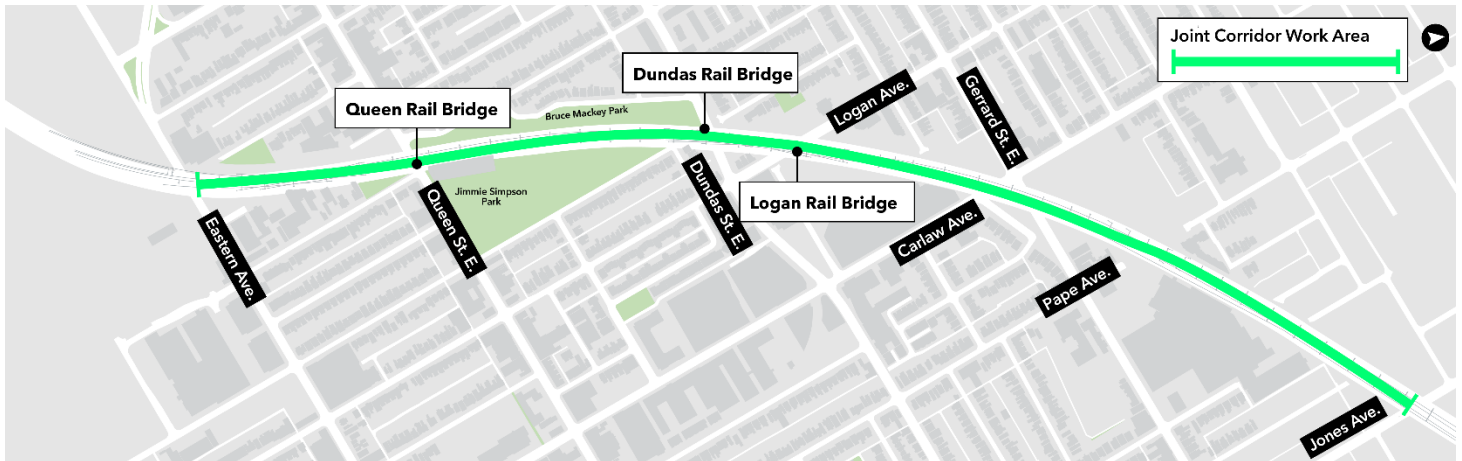


Completion of the Early Works Stage in the Lakeshore East Joint Corridor

Expected Duration: Until end of Fall 2026

Hours of work:

- **Daytime:** Monday to Friday, with occasional weekend work, from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.
- **Evening/overnight:** Monday to Friday from 7 p.m. - 5 a.m.



What is happening?

- The Early Works stage is nearing completion. **This stage includes the reconstruction of the new rail bridges at Queen St. E., Dundas St. E., and Logan Ave., the widening of the rail corridor, and installation of noise barriers.**
- Over the next few months, crews will be conducting work activities in and around the rail corridor between Eastern Ave. and Jones Ave. to bring the Early Works stage to completion. This includes:
 - Landscaping restoration
 - Installing fencing and utilities
 - Rail works (track resurfacing)
- As part of finalization work, anti-graffiti coating will continue to be applied to the bridges and parts of the retaining wall surrounding the bridges. This work started in the week of August 10 and will take approximately 1-3 days to complete the application at and around each bridge. Intermittent sidewalk closures will be required for safety.
- Overnight work may be required for some of the work activities. Track work can only be safely completed when trains are not running.
- Times and locations for where work will occur are approximate and are subject to change.

What to expect

- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
