

Caledonia GO Weekend Corridor Works

Scheduled Start Date: Friday, September 18, 2026*

Scheduled End Date: Monday, September 21, 2026*

Working Hours: Continuous day and night from 11:00 p.m. on Friday until 6:00 a.m. on Monday.

**Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances*

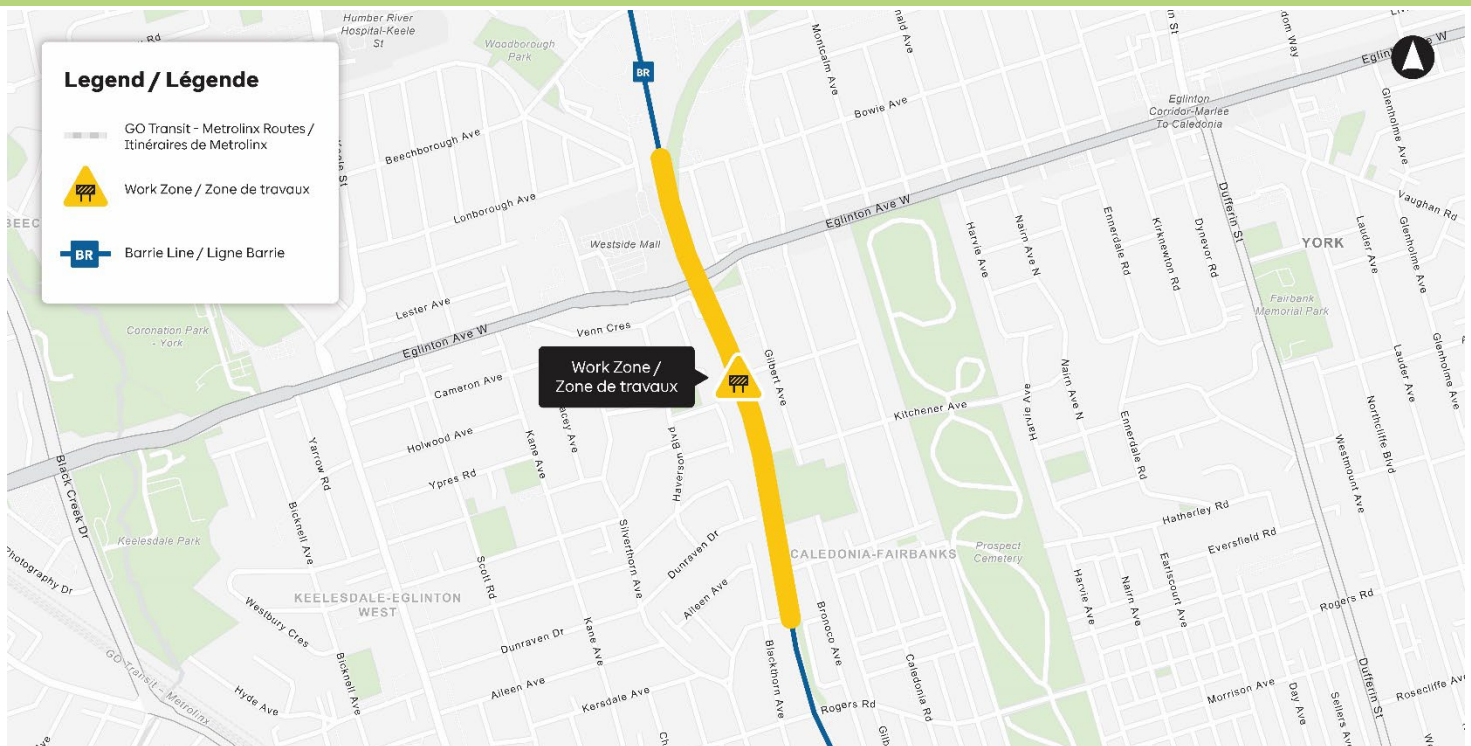


Figure 1: Map showing the extent of the work area. Metrolinx image.

What is Happening?

As part of construction for the future Caledonia GO Station, crews will be conducting track resurfacing and ballast/sub-ballast replacement within the Barrie rail corridor (see Figure 1).

This work will occur over a weekend service pause of the Barrie GO rail line, allowing crews to work safely on the track without live trains passing through.

What to Expect?

- Construction lighting may be visible from the work site.
- Where possible, lights from equipment will be positioned away from residential homes to keep light pollution levels low.
- No additional dust is expected in the area.
- No utilities disruptions are anticipated.
- No impact on driveway access in the construction area.
- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
- Trucks will enter the site at the Keith Avenue access gate and leave via 150 Bronoco Avenue.

Traffic Changes

- No disruptions to traffic are anticipated.

Pedestrian Access

- All pedestrian sidewalks will remain open throughout the work.

Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience intermittent noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.
- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.
- Trucks accessing the site will be equipped with broadband backup alarms, which emit a less disruptive sound compared to traditional beeping backup alarms.
