

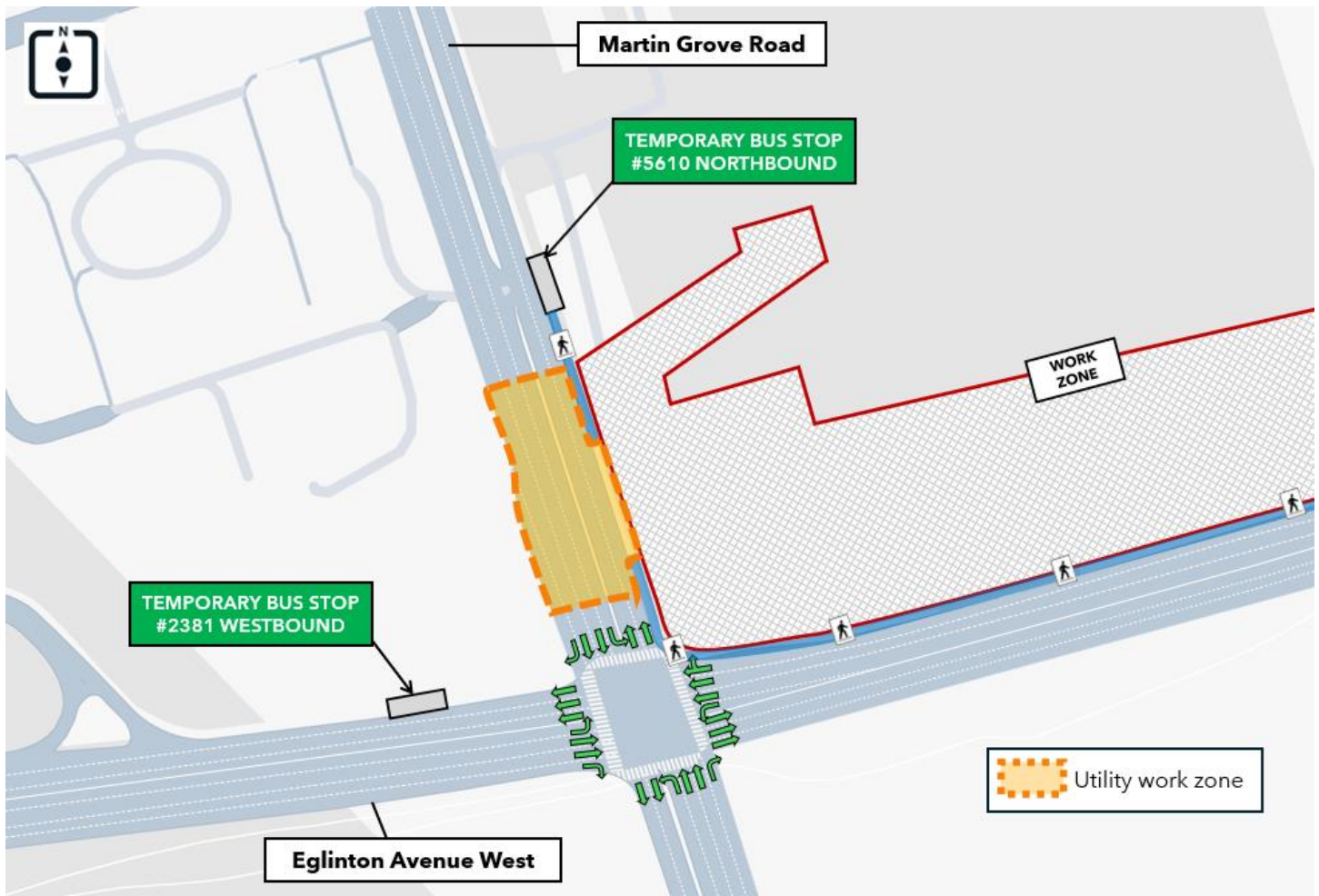
Utility work at Martin Grove Road and Eglinton Avenue West

Scheduled start date: Thursday, September 17, 2026

Expected completion: Thursday, October 15, 2026

Construction hours: Weekdays - 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Occasional weekend work required.

What is happening?

- Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be completing utility work as part of station box construction at Martin Grove Road and Eglinton Avenue West.
- This work includes the completion of associated underground utility work on Martin Grove Road, north of Eglinton Avenue West.
- To complete this work, a portion of the north median at the Martin Grove Road and Eglinton Avenue West intersection will be removed.
- A station box is an underground box-like structure that forms the main body of a transit station.

What to expect

- Residents can expect to see and hear noise from large machinery, such as drills, excavators, dump trucks and equipment. Construction lighting may be visible on the work site.
- Measures are being put in place to reduce dust, including the use of water sprayers and biodegradable dust suppressants.
- Overnight work may be required. Residents will be provided with updates as they are made available.
- The information provided is anticipated based on the current construction schedule and is subject to change.
- Work is subject to permit approval from the City of Toronto.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

- Intermittent lane closures will be required on Martin Grove Road as work progresses through different stages. Only one of the following lane closure configurations will be in place at a time:
 - One northbound curb lane;
 - One northbound through lane and one southbound through lane; or
 - One southbound curb lane.
- A portion of the northeast sidewalk on Martin Grove Road will be temporarily closed for approximately one week.
- At least one northbound through lane and one southbound through lane on Martin Grove Road will be maintained at all times.
- Short-term traffic configuration changes and road restoration will take place between each stage of work and once the work is complete.
- Signage and traffic control measures will be in place to safely guide motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians through the area.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.

- The extension of Line 5 Eglinton will run 9.2 kilometres from Mount Dennis Station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.

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
