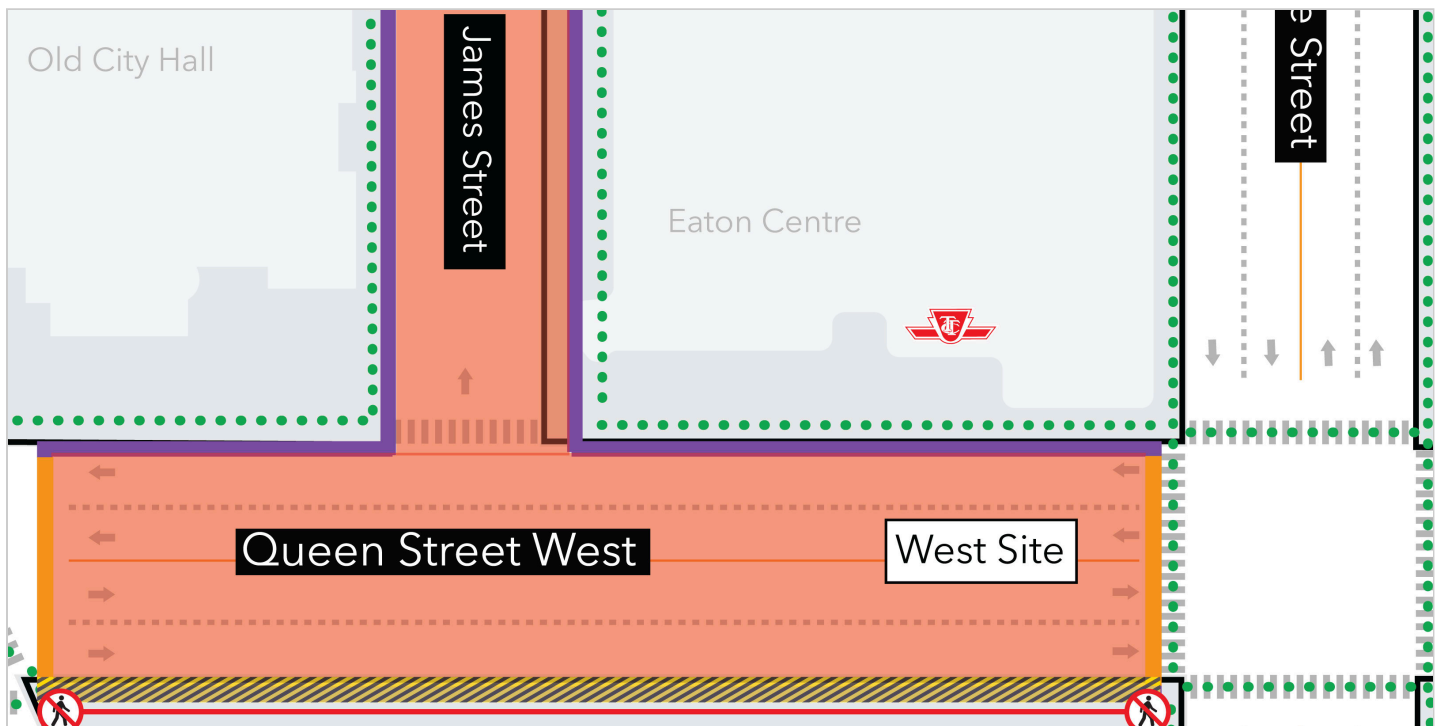


# Overnight Sidewalk Closure along Queen St West
