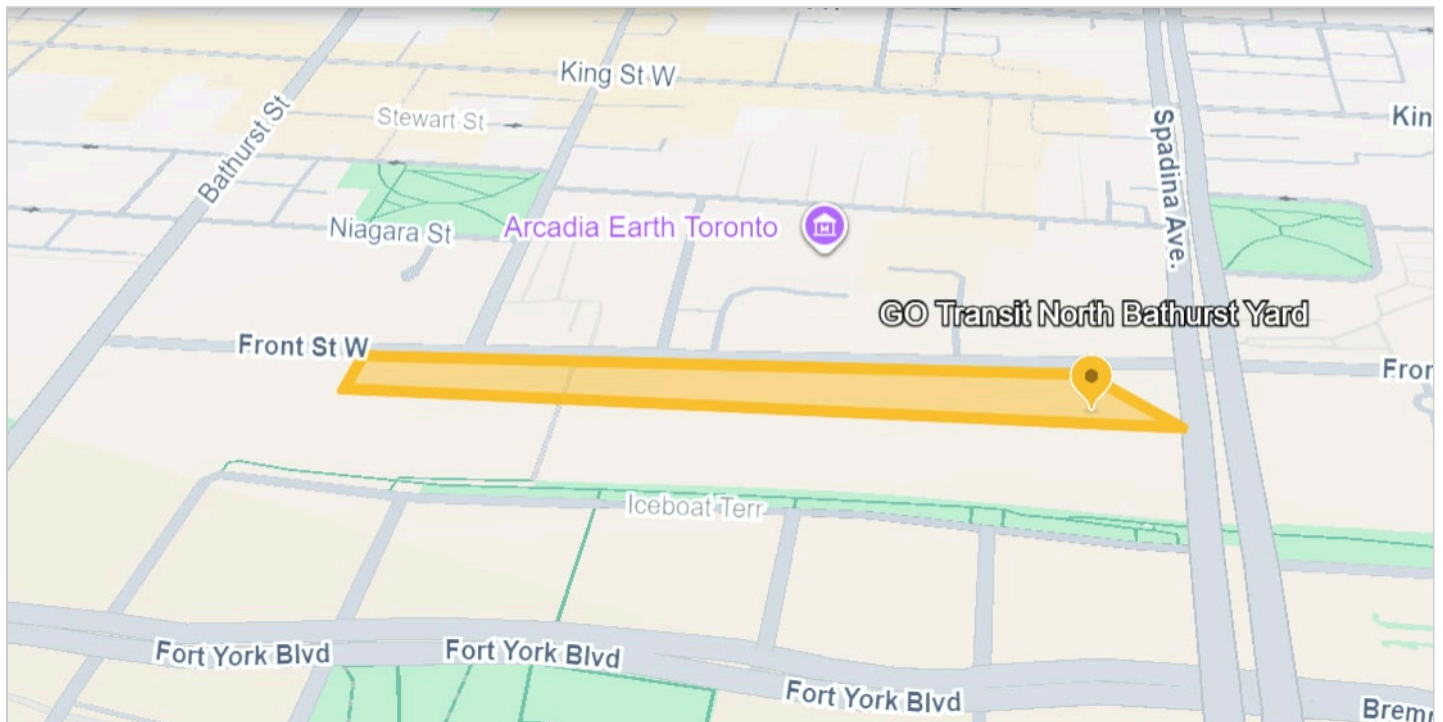


Union Station - Additional Overnight Train Storage Activity – Bathurst Yard

Scheduled Start Date: May 22, 2026

Scheduled End Date: May 25, 2026

Working Hours: Friday night to Monday 5:00 a.m., 24 hours

What Is Happening?

Significant construction and rehabilitation work planned for select station, bridge and track infrastructure along the Lake Shore West corridor will require the increased capacity of the Bathurst Yard train facility to accommodate additional VIA trains. Due to insufficient wayside power capacity, trains will be idling overnight. Crews will do their best to mitigate noise impacts in the area.

What to Expect?

- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Increased train activity within the Bathurst Yard.
- Due lack of sufficient wayside power, trains will be idling overnight.

Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.
