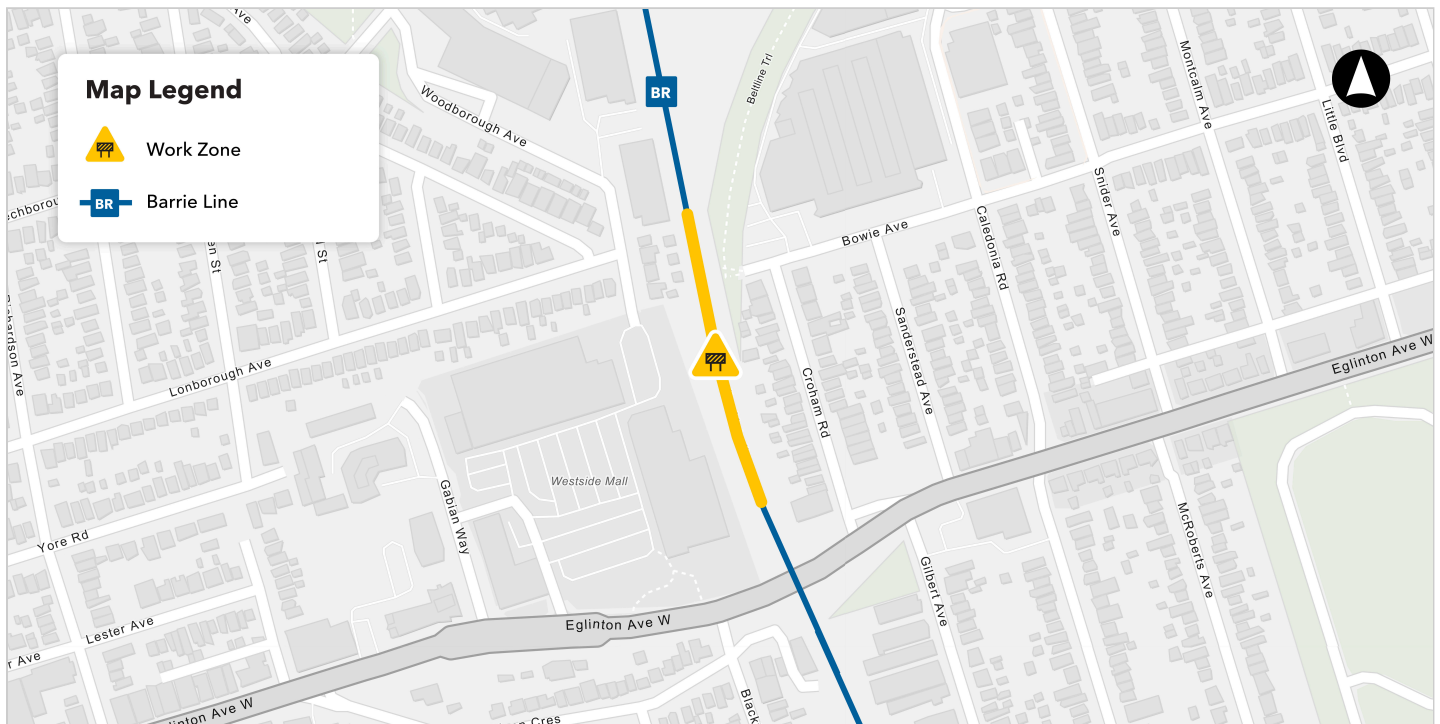


# Caledonia GO Station Weekend Works

## What Is Happening?

As part of work on the future Caledonia GO Station, Metrolinx crews will be working over two weekends to complete various construction activities, including drilling, electrical service installation, and caisson installations. These works will occur over the weekend on May 23-24, 2026, and May 30-31, 2026, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Activities will take place within the Barrie rail corridor during a weekend pause in service of the Barrie GO line. This will help ensure the safety of our crews, as they will be able to work on the track without trains in service.

## What to Expect?

- Trucks and construction equipment may generate dust during construction.
- Crews will take precautions to monitor and reduce dust.
- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Trucks will stage inside the work site and will not stage outside of the site boundaries

## Traffic Changes

- No disruptions to traffic are anticipated.

## Pedestrian Access

- All pedestrian sidewalks will remain open throughout the work.

## Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.
- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.
- To minimize noise impacts on the community, noise and vibration monitoring equipment will be installed prior to construction. These devices will help to detect exceedances early to proactively conduct corrective actions as needed while crews work.

## Transit Service

- The Barrie GO rail line will be closed for the duration of the work. Signs will be posted to keep residents informed.

Caledonia GO Station is a brand-new station on the Barrie Line and will be directly integrated with Line 5 Eglinton and TTC buses. Located on Eglinton Avenue just west of Caledonia Road, the fully accessible station will be a major transfer point, offering a new way to travel downtown, up north and across the city. This will give customers more options for reaching their destinations, whether they're commuting to work, visiting family or exploring the city, ensuring a smoother, more affordable journey.
