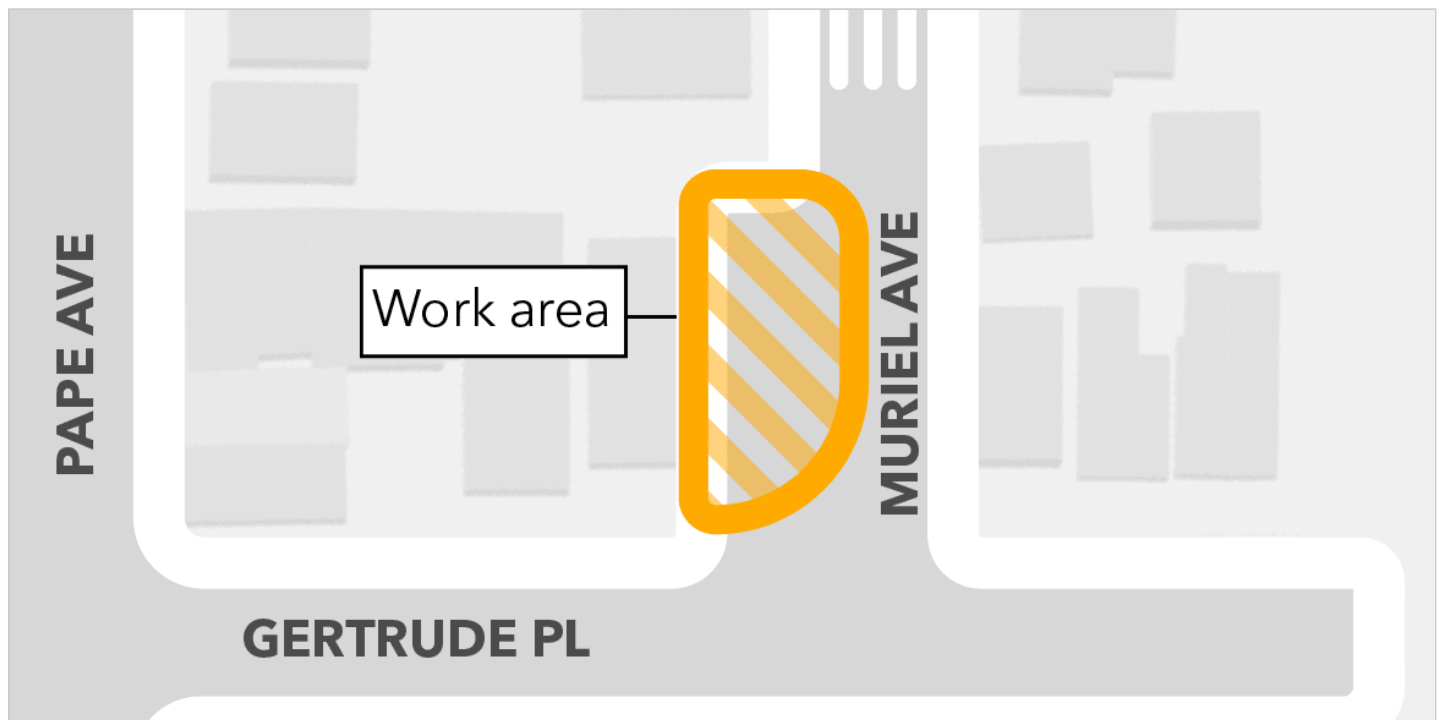


Hydrovac work at Gertrude Place and Muriel Ave

What Is Happening?

Crews will be using a hydro-vac truck within the construction zone at the north west corner of Gertrude Place and Muriel Avenue.

What to Expect?

- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Traffic Changes

- No disruptions to traffic are anticipated.

Pedestrian Access

- All pedestrian sidewalks will remain open throughout the work.

Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.

- There is no anticipated impact to transit services.
