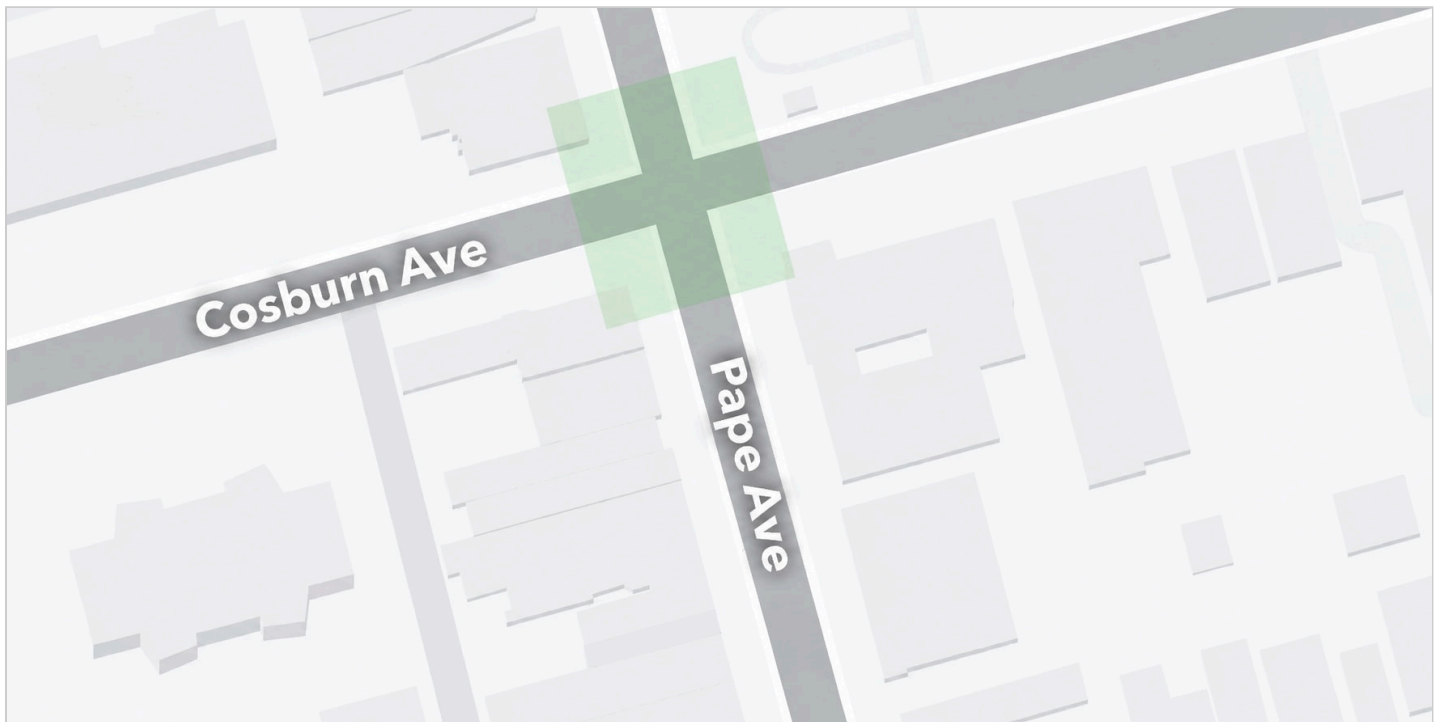


Upcoming Traffic Signalling Works at Cosburn Station

Scheduled Start Date: June 08, 2026

Scheduled End Date: July 10, 2026

Working Hours: Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.



Crews will be working to install temporary traffic signals at the Pape and Cosburn intersection.

What Is Happening?

To accommodate future construction activities and changes to the traffic configuration at Cosburn Station, crews will install temporary traffic signals at Pape Avenue and Cosburn Avenue.

What to Expect?

- Trucks and construction equipment may generate dust during construction.
- Crews will take precautions to monitor and reduce dust.
- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Traffic Changes

- Minor delays may be experienced near the work zone.
- Two-way directional traffic will be maintained during the work.
- A paid duty officer, flaggers and detour signs will be onsite to direct traffic as needed.

Pedestrian Access

- Temporary sidewalk closures or pedestrian detours will be in place while the work is underway, with signs in place to direct pedestrians as needed.
- Pedestrian detours may be required, with signs in place to direct pedestrians as needed.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.
- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.

Transit Service

- There is no anticipated impact to transit services.
