## Gardiner Off-Ramp to Yonge Street

### What Is Happening?

The Yonge Street Gardiner off-ramp closure is necessary to facilitate the installation of temporary construction barriers along the north boulevard adjacent to the west bound Gardiner off ramp to Yonge Street and install the remaining fencing along the adjacent northern boulevard.

## What to Expect?

- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.

## Traffic Changes

- The Gardiner off-ramp exit to Yonge Street will be closed for the duration of the work. Signage will redirect traffic around the work zones.

## Noise & Vibration

- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.
