

UPDATED: Bell Utilities Relocation Work - Pape Avenue and Bain Avenue Intersection Area

What Is Happening?

Crews will be working to relocate Bell utilities near the intersection of Pape Avenue and Bain Avenue.

What to Expect?

- Trucks and construction equipment may generate dust during construction.
- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- On-street parking will be restricted on Pape Avenue between Bain Avenue and Withrow Avenue. Alternative parking is available in the Lane East Pape South Riverdale.

Traffic Changes

- Pape Avenue will be reduced for the duration of the work. Signage will redirect traffic around the work zones.
- A paid duty officer, flaggers and detour signs will be onsite to direct traffic as needed.
- All businesses in the area will remain open during the work. Please follow signage for access.

Pedestrian Access

- Pedestrian detours may be required, with signs in place to direct pedestrians as needed.

Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.

Transit Service

- There is no anticipated impact to transit services.
