Working Hours: Friday to Monday, 24 hours

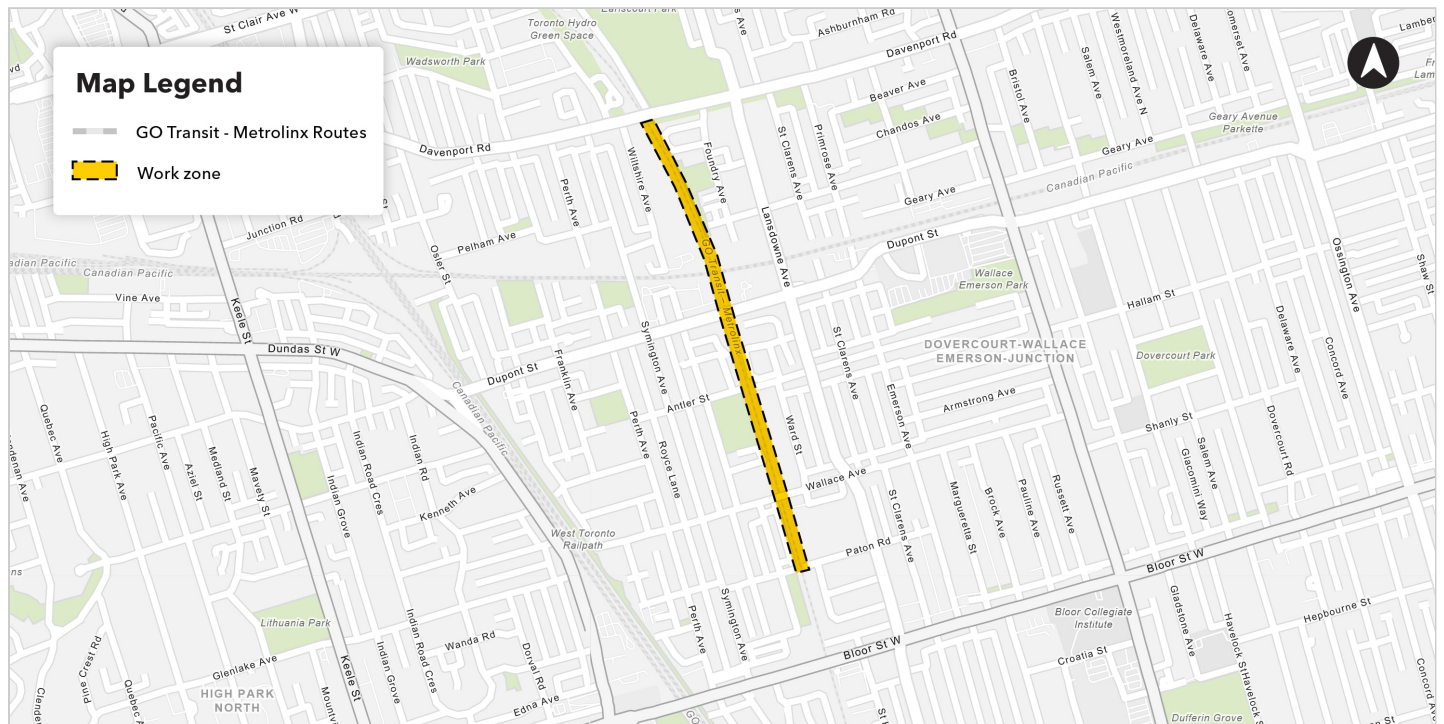


Figure 1: Map depicting work zone. Metrolinx image.

What Is Happening?

Contracted crews will be working along the Davenport Diamond Guideway to complete additional electrical work, including raising an existing duct bank and repairing electrical conduit connections. This work will occur during a scheduled pause in service on the Barrie GO rail line over the July 24-26 weekend.

What to Expect?

- Construction lighting may be visible from the work site.
- Where possible, lights from equipment will be positioned away from residential homes to keep light pollution levels low.
- Trucks and construction equipment may generate dust during construction.
- Crews will take precautions to monitor and reduce dust.
- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.

Traffic Changes

- No disruptions to traffic are anticipated.

Pedestrian Access

- All pedestrian sidewalks will remain open throughout the work.

Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.
- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.

The Davenport Diamond refers to the intersection where the Barrie GO corridor met the CP rail tracks. It was one of the busiest train intersections in North America. The Davenport Diamond Guideway allows GO trains travel above traffic and the CP rail tracks, reducing congestion and improving service reliability.
