What Is Happening?

As construction on the Hazel McCallion Line LRT continues to progress, crews continue to carry out work along Hurontario Street from Burnhamthorpe Road to Eglinton Avenue. Ongoing construction activities in the coming months include continued track installations on the elevated guideway, track maintenance, ongoing construction at the City Centre Stop, ongoing utility relocations and ongoing work at stops. Some of this work may be scheduled overnight and on weekends for a variety of reasons. We thank you for your patience as we work to deliver this transformative project.

What to Expect?

- Construction lighting may be visible from the work site.
- Trucks and construction equipment may generate dust during construction.
- Crews will take precautions to monitor and reduce dust.
- Increased presence of construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public safety.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Traffic Changes

- Minor delays may be experienced near the work zone.

Pedestrian Access

- Temporary sidewalk closures or pedestrian detours will be in place while the work is underway, with signs in place to direct pedestrians as needed.
- Pedestrian detours may be required, with signs in place to direct pedestrians as needed.

Noise & Vibration

- Residences and businesses in the area may experience noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.
- Crews will take measures to minimize disruptions to the surrounding area wherever possible.
- Residences and businesses in the area can expect noise and vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work.

Once in service, the 18-kilometre Hazel McCallion Line will bring a new, environmentally friendly and reliable method of transportation to a rapidly growing region. The new transit system will feature 19 stops, travel through two urban growth centres and connect to major transit systems including GO Transit (Milton and Lakeshore West lines), the Mississauga Transitway, Brampton Transit, ZUM and MiWay. The Hazel McCallion Line will operate in its own dedicated lane ensuring a smooth, reliable and convenient ride along the region's busiest street.
